That's I.A. 2013-05 You are being interviewed as a witness to this Internal Affairs Investigation. Since you are not the focus of this investigation, you do not need a union representative or an attorney present to represent you in this case. You are required to answer all of my questions pertaining to your actions or knowledge obtained while employed with the City of North Miami. Failure to answer any question may subject you to disciplinary action. If at any time during this interview you feel that your answers might result in disciplinary action against you, advise me and the interview will be stopped until you obtain union representation. This interview is being recorded. Mr. Fernandez, please raise your right hand. Do you solemnly swear or affirm that everything you say during this interview will be the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth?

A I do.

Q Mr. Fernandez, if it is determined that you have not spoken the truth, you may be charged with criminal perjury, do you understand this fact?

A I do.

Q For the record can you state your name, first name, last name and spell it for me please?

A Otoniel Fernandez, O-T-O-N-I-E-L. Fernandez F-E-R-N-A-N-D-E-Z.

Q And what is your job title?

A Patrol K-9.

Q And you're a Police Officer?

A Yes sir.

Q What shift do you work for?

A Day shift.

Q What are your responsibilities as a K-9 Officer on the day shift?

A Patrol and respond to calls.

Q How long have you been employed with the City of North Miami?

A Fourteen years.

Q All as a Law Enforcement Officer?

A Yes sir.

Q Where do you conduct your work? What is the address to the station?

A 700 N.E. 124, City of North Miami 330...33161.

Q On October 19th, 2013, it shows that you responded to 13695 West Dixie Highway as a Backup Officer on an in-progress call. Do you recall?

A Yes.

Q According to the detail call for service log, it appears you responded in reference to an in-progress call. Can you tell me what transpired?

A If I recall, I don't remember if there was a 26 in-progress or a fight or something.

Q And what is a 26 in-progress?

A BURGLARY in-progress.

Q Okay.

A By the time I got there I would say nine units there already.

Q Do you remember...you said there were nine units there?

A Ball park figure, I can't remember exactly how many cars.

Q Do you remember who the Officers were?

A I know Officer Aledda was there. I remember Bernadeau if I'm mistaken. I can't remember who else was there. It was a lot of cars. I think Officer Becker was there.

Q When you tell me the Officers that were there, I need you to be...out of the Officers that you do tell me were there I need you to be 100% sure that these Officers were there. If you don't remember other Officers just say that there were other Officers and I don't remember who they were. Are you sure that Aledda was there?

A Yeah, I remember.

Q Are you sure that Bernadeau was there?

A Now I can't recall.

Q And are you sure that Becker was there?

A I think he was there but I'm not sure 100%. I dealt with Aledda the whole time because he was...I guess he was handling the call.

Q So that leads me to my next question. Do you remember who the Lead Officer on the call was?

A I think it was Aledda.

Q And why do you think it was Aledda?

A He's the one talking to me all the time.

Q He was the one that seemed like...

A Yeah he in was in charge yeah.

Q And I understand you were K-9, did you have any K-9 type of work done at the call or you were just there to assist as a Police Officer?

A By the time I got there no K-9 was needed. Everybody was there. I guess they had everybody separated or something. When I got there, there was nothing going on except they were trying to decipher what was going on with the whole argument and everything.

Q And when you say that there was an argument and that people were separated, who was the argument between and who was separated?

A I don't know names. I know there was a Haitian male and two white males but I don't know their names.

Q The Haitian male was a black male?

A Yes.

Q And the other two gentlemen, they were white males?

A Yes.

Q Do you know where they were from? Did they have an accent?

A I actually didn't talk to them.

Q You didn't talk to the white males?

A No.

Q Did you talk to the black male?

A No. These people were talking to them while I was there.

Q How do you know he was Haitian?

A Cause I heard him talking to Aledda and I heard him talking to the other Officers.

Q Do you know if anybody was arrested at this call?

A I think the Haitian male was arrested. I'm not mistaken, I don't know. I know somebody was taken to jail but I don't remember who, the white male was...there was a whole fiasco and basically I was inside most of the time in the restaurant trying to find out with Aledda who owned the restaurant or something. Because it was a dispute over who owned the restaurant and I guess the other people were saying they owned it and the Haitian male said he owned it. So I was in the kitchen actually in the office trying to decipher who owned it.

Q So to reiterate and correct me if I'm wrong. You do know an arrest was made but you don't...

A Exactly, I don't recall.

Q And your role at this call was mostly to assist Officer Aledda in verifying who the owner of the business was?

A Yes. I think I had him call dispatch to see what the tax roles and all that stuff was.

Q Did you finally verify who the owner of the business was?

A I don't know if he was able to determine.

Q But you didn't determine anything?

A No, no, no. There was paperwork there from another company and we tried to make contact with the other company and nobody responded. So I have no idea.

Q So you don't know if the owner was determined based on...

A No.

Q ...you being there because...did you leave?

A Yeah I left. I left.

Q How long were you at the call for?

A I don't remember now. I can't recall now.

Q Did you transport anybody?

A No.

Q Do you remember if anyone transported anybody?

A I can't recall right now.

Q Do you remember if anybody was in handcuffs?

A To tell you the truth, I don't remember.

Q Do you remember seeing either the Haitian black male or the two white males in the back of a Police car?

A Right now I can't remember.

Q Do you remember anybody being injured in any way?

A I can't recall.

Q Do you remember if anyone was transported anywhere by anyone?

A When I was there I didn't see anybody get transported. So I have no idea. I couldn't recall. I couldn't tell you.

Q Did anyone make any statements to you about anybody being arrested or anybody being transported anywhere or anybody being injured?

A That I can remember now, no.

Q Do you recall if Officer Aledda or Officer Bernadeau handcuffed or arrested or transported anyone regarding this incident?

A I can't remember.

Q Did you respond because they requested additional backup or did you respond...why did you respond?

A No I respond...I was coming from the Motor Pool and I just...I was driving by and I stopped. Because there was enough units there before so.

Q So you just stopped by to see if they needed additional help?

A Yeah. I even had to park in the middle of Dixie Highway because there was no place to park on the parking lot.

Q Do you remember anyone...any Police Officer using any type of force on anyone on the scene whether it was justified or unjustified, whether it was excessive or not excessive?

A By the time I got there I didn't see anybody using force on anybody because everybody was basically separated.

Q Other than the role that you played in attempting to verify the ownership of the restaurant, did you play any other role?

A I think I tried closing...attempted to try to close the door of the restaurant because someone had broken the door lock or something.

Q So you attempted to secure the business?

A Yeah. But I couldn't, there was no way to do it.

Q Other than attempting to secure the business and attempting to verify who the owner of the business was, did you play any other role?

A No.

Q Is there any other information that you...by the way, did you author any documents?

A That I recall, no.

Q Did you respond to the station and see anyone in the holding cell related to this call?

A I tell you right now I can't remember. October...I can't remember. It wasn't even my call so I can't...you know what, I probably did. I probably didn't. I have no idea.

Q Is there any other information or evidence that you would like to add at this time?

A No.

Q Mr. Fernandez, is there anything that I have failed to ask you that you would like to add at this time?

A No.

Q Mr. Fernandez, has everything you said been the truth to the best of your knowledge?

A Yes sir.

Q Mr. Fernandez, you are advised that under Chapter 112.533 Subsection 3, entitled disclosure of Internal Affairs Complaints, any person who is a participant in an Internal Affairs Investigation who willfully discloses any information obtained pursuant to the agencies investigation including but not limited to the identity of the Officer or Officers under investigation, the nature of the questions asked, information revealed or documents furnished in connection with a confidential investigation of an agency before such complaint, document, action or proceeding becomes a public record as provided by this section is guilty of a misdemeanor of the first degree; punishable as provided in Section 775.082 Penalties and Section 77.083 Fines. Do you have any further information that you wish to add?

A No.

Q Mr. Fernandez, this concludes the interview. The time is now 4:19 P.M. Thank you for your cooperation. Since this investigation is continuing, you are hereby ordered not to discuss the details of this investigation except with legal counsel or a union representative if you see fit. Thank you sir.

A Okay, thank you.

Q Mr. Calderon, you are being interview as the witness of an Internal Affairs Investigation that I'm investigating. This is a sworn statement in reference to Internal Affairs Case No. I.A. 2013-05. That's I. A. 2013-05. You are being interviewed as a witness to this Internal Affairs Investigation. Since you are not the focus of this investigation, you do not need a union representative or an attorney present to represent you in this case. You are required to answer all of my questions pertaining to your actions or knowledge obtained while employed with the City of North Miami. Failure to answer any question may subject you to disciplinary action. If at any time during this interview you feel that your answers might result in disciplinary action against you, advise me and the interview will be stopped until you obtain union representation. This interview is being recorded. Mr. Calderon, please raise your right hand. Do you solemnly swear or affirm that everything you say during this interview will be the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth?

A Yes I do.

Q Mr. Calderon, if it is determined that you have not spoken the truth, you may be charged with criminal perjury, do you understand this fact?

A Yes.

Q For the record please, what is your full name and job title?

A My name is Jean Pierre Calderon. I'm a Police Officer.

Q What section do you work for? Section will be either Uniform Patrol or Investigations?

A Uniform Patrol.

Q Uniform Patrol and what shift do you work on?

A Afternoon shift.

Q What are your responsibilities as a Police Officer on the afternoon shift?

A To respond to calls for service.

Q How long have you been employed with the City of North Miami?

A Since this year June 26th.

Q So that's approximately...

A Six months.

Q Have all six months been as a Police Officer?

A Yes.

Q Where do you conduct your work, what is the address of the station?

A 700 N.E. 124th Street, North Miami, Florida 33161.

Q Mr. Calderon, on October 19th, 2013, you responded to 13695 West Dixie Highway as a Back up Officer on an in-progress call. Do you remember that?

A Yes.

Q According to the detail call for service log, it appears you responded in reference to either a BURGLARY or a ROBBERY in progress. Do you remember responding...

A Yes.

Q ...in reference to that. Do you remember who the Lead Officer or Officers were?

A I believe the Lead Officer was Officer Aledda.

Q Were you the initial Backup or were you an additional Backup?

A I was an additional Backup.

Q Were you dispatched as an additional Backup or did you just decide to take an additional Backup on your own?

A I decided to take the additional Backup.

Q According to the report two subjects were arrested that night. Do you recall those arrests?

A Like the charges?

Q Do you recall the arrest period? Do you recall two subjects being arrested?

A Yes.

Q Can you describe the subjects that were arrested to me?

A They were both white males. One of them was 5'6". The other one maybe about 5'8". They were both from Russia.

Q Did you speak to these gentlemen?

A Yes I did.

Q And did they both tell you that they were Russian? Well how did you know they were Russian?

A One of them didn't speak English. He told us.

Q One of them did not speak English.

A No.

Q How did you know they were Russian?

A He said it. We asked him.

Q Now two subjects were arrested. Do you remember who the victim on this case was?

A Yes it was...I don't remember his name but he was the new owner of the business.

Q The new owner. Can you describe the new owner to me?

A He was a Haitian black male.

Q How do you know he was Haitian?

A The way he spoke.

Q Like an accent?

A His accent.

Q And do you remember speaking to the new owner?

A I didn't speak to him.

Q You didn't speak to him that much, okay. Do you remember arriving there immediately as this was going on in-progress or did you come way after the fact?

A Not way after the fact. It was just after...it was about four Police Officers who were there. I arrived just after.

Q Do you recall anyone being handcuffed in your presence?

A Yes.

Q Who do you remember being handcuffed?

A The new owner.

Q The new owner was being handcuffed.

A Yes.

Q Was he the only person being handcuffed at that time?

A At the time yes.

Q So the new owner was handcuffed. Do you remember who handcuffed the new owner?

A It was me.

Q You handcuffed him?

A Yes.

Q Can you tell me in your own words when you arrived, what did you see, what happened?

A As soon as I arrived I saw like them three Police Officers.

Q Do you remember who the Police Officers were?

A It was Officer Aledda, Officer Becker and I do not remember the third one. But they were trying to apprehend the new owner and he was resisting.

Q So the new owner was resisting?

A Yes.

Q They were trying to apprehend him how?

A By trying to just place him in cuffs. To find out what was going on at the time and he started resisting and tensing up. At that time we all...they were grabbing him already and they like kind of directed him towards the wall.

Q When you say they we're talking about those other Police Officers.

A Those Officers.

Q Talking about Aledda, Becker and another Officer that you don't remember. And you're saying he was tensing up and you were trying to get him against the wall so that you could handcuff him.

A They were.

Q They were, okay. And why were they trying to handcuff him, do you remember? Or why were they trying to detain him, do you remember why?

A Well after...we finally got his hands behind his back. I cuffed him. After all of that I found out that once Officer Aledda arrived, he was the first one on scene. He was holding a gun or he had a gun in the car and he was going to the car. And Aledda gave him a command to get down on the ground and he refused. And that's when he started getting like belligerent. At that time we didn't know who was who.

Q So Aledda gave him a command.

A Yes.

Q To do what?

A To get on the ground.

Q Were you there when Aledda gave him the command?

A No.

Q Aledda told you about this?

A (Inaudible).

Q So Aledda told you that he gave him a command to get on the ground and he decided not to get on the ground?

A Yes. I believe he walked towards the car. Once he told him to get on the ground, he walked towards the car.

Q He told him to get on the ground and he walked towards the car.

A Yes.

Q And did Aledda know that in the car there was a gun?

A Yes at the time he did.

Q So Aledda knew there was a gun in the car. So he saw that the guy was going to the car and Aledda said get on the ground.

A Yes.

Q But the guy what? The guy continued walking to the car?

A Now I remember correctly. He got on one knee...Aledda told me he got on one knee. And as a second Officer pulled up, he got up and started walking towards the car. I'm not sure but I believe he had an empty holster in his waist band.

Q He had an empty holster in the waist band?

A Yes.

Q And the empty holster was visible?

A Yes.

Q So the empty holster was visible when the...the empty holster was visible to you when you were there?

A When I was there...I hope I'm not mistaken for another call. But I have a feeling he had an empty holster and he was walking towards the car. I remember Aledda telling me about the knee part. He got on one knee and he got up.

Q So we're not sure about the empty holster but we are sure about him getting on one knee.

A And another Police Officer pulling up and then him getting up.

Q And this is something that you did not witness. This is something that Aledda is telling you, okay. So when you get there you have no idea what's going on. You just know that Aledda and two other Officers are attempting to hold him.

A Yes.

Q And put him against the wall so that they can restrain him.

A Yes.

Q You notice that there was some type of altercation, some type of resistance and you basically just assisted Aledda, Becker and this other unknown Officer to handcuff this person.

A Yes.

Q And the handcuffs that were used to handcuff him were your handcuffs?

A My handcuffs.

Q So you get handcuffs on him and what happens after that?

A After that Rescue arrives. One of the guys who were arrested, he was there holding his lip. I don't know if it was his lip or...he was bleeding.

Q So one of the other gentlemen. The white Russian guy was holding his lip.

A He was there holding his lip.

Q Why was he holding his lip?

A The guy that we handcuffed he...later on we found out that he hit him with the gun.

Q So the new owner who's the black male with a gun, this is the information that you found out later had struck the Russian guy on the lip and that's why he was holding it for. And how did you find this information out?

A That's from all the Officers. We were talking to everyone there on the scene and we finally got the whole story.

Q So it wasn't information that you obtained specifically from the white males. Something that was told to you by one of the Officers that were there and you don't remember who.

A No.

Q So once he's handcuffed, the black male, what do we do with him? Was he patted down?

A From there on I remember handcuffing him. I turned around. He was taking to Aledda's car.

Q He was taken not by you by somebody else?

A Yes.

Q So basically your role there was just to handcuff him.

A Handcuff him. As soon as he was cuffed, I remember turning around. And I'm speaking to the one with the bloody lip. I took out my pad and I got all of his information.

Q Okay so you got...the male with the bloody lip, you got his info.

A Yes. And I started getting Rescue's info. And since I was a 15 I started getting just all the written info just so I can give it to the Primary Officer.

Q And the Primary Officer is Aledda?

A Yes.

Q What did you see...what happened to this black male gentleman? Where did they take him? Did they sit him down? Did they put him in a car? What did they do?

A He was taken to the back of Aledda's car. I don't remember if it was immediately. I don't remember if he was seated down on the ground first and then taken to Aledda's car but I know he ended up.

Q But at some point...we don't know what happened. If he was asked to sit on the floor or if he was asked...but at some point you do know that the end result of that was that he was taken to the back seat of Aledda's car.

A Yes.

Q Was the door closed?

A Yes.

Q And he remained handcuffed?

A Yes.

Q Behind his back?

A Yes.

Q Okay.

A Window down too.

Q With the window down. Was he injured?

A No.

Q Did he complain of any injuries?

A No.

Q Did you notice any injuries?

A No sir.

Q Did you notice any Officer doing anything that may have injured this gentleman?

A No.

Q Did you notice any Officer use any type of excessive use of force?

A No.

Q Did you use any excessive use of force?

A No.

Q Did you transport anyone at any time?

A I transported the...one of the Russians to the station.

Q The one with the bloody lip or the other one?

A No the other one.

Q So you transported the Russian that did not have a bloody lip to where?

A Yes to the station, to the holding cell.

Q To the holding cell. When you got to the holding cell with the white Russian male. Not the one with the bloody lip but the other one. That's the one that didn't speak English correct?

A Yes.

Q When you're bringing him into the station, was he handcuffed?

A Yes.

Q Was he under arrest?

A Yes.

Q What was he under arrest for?

A At that time I think he was being detained.

Q But you're bringing him to the station?

A Yeah I was told to bring him from that location to the station. He was being detained at the time.

Q You were told by whom?

A I don't remember if it was a supervisor or Aledda.

Q So somebody told you to bring this gentleman to the station.

A Yeah he was going to go to the station too.

Q When you get to the station with this subject, was the black male gentleman, was he at the station at the time?

A Yes he was.

Q And where was he?

A In a holding cell.

Q He was inside of a holding cell.

A Yes.

Q Was he handcuffed?

A I don't think so. I'm not sure but...

Q You're not sure, okay. And the white male, was he placed into a holding cell?

A Yes.

Q Did you remain in the holding cell area for a long time?

A Yes I was there.

Q How long were you there for?

A Approximately 30 to 40 minutes.

Q In those 30 to 40 minutes, was this black male gentleman, was he released at any point?

A He was released, yes.

Q When we say released, can you describe what that means?

A He was given his property back. He signed the property receipt. I remember we spoke to him about how he dealt with the situation. At the time we didn't know he was the victim. We kind of explained to him, look if you're a victim again try to deal with a little bit different. We understand you were mad. This is why we took these actions and he understood.

Q So you explained to him. I'm just going to reiterate what you said. You explained to him that the way that he handled the situation was not the best way to handle a situation.

A Yes.

Q Why do you feel it wasn't the best way? What was it that he did that you feel was not the right way to handle it?

A Well we got there he was acting...he wasn't listening to the commands. And we're trying to handcuff him and he was tensing up. So the guy...the actual subjects the one with the bloody lip and the other guy, they were just standing there. So...

Q Cause all the attention was focused on this gentleman.

A Especially me. I'm showing up. As soon as I get to the scene cuffs...the Officers are grabbing that guy and those guys are just there standing doing nothing. So...

Q So you feel that because of the actions of this gentleman all the attention was focused on him and at that time it just seemed that he was the subject that needed to be restrained or whatever.

A Yes.

Q At that time did you have any information about a gun? You specifically?

A At the time...I think I knew by dispatch.

Q By dispatch. Dispatch had advised you that the subject had a gun.

A I don't know.

Q You don't remember. So you explain this to this gentleman that he should have handled this in a different manner.

A Yes.

Q Did you explain that to him specifically?

A No, I was sitting down. It was Sergeant Mesidor.

Q So Sergeant Mesidor explained to him...

A Yes.

Q ...how he handled the situation and how he should have handled the situation.

A Yes.

Q And he was released and he was given all his property back?

A Yes.

Q Were you present when it was verified that he was the owner for the business and he was actually the victim?

A Yes, that happened at the scene.

Q That happened at the scene.

A At the scene.

Q So at the scene was when he was verified that he was the owner?

A Not verified. Actually no it happened at the holding cell because he had...I don't know who he had to call. But he had to call somebody to verify. Sergeant Mesidor verified that he just recently brought the property.

Q So this gentleman asked Sergeant Mesidor to contact somebody who was going to verify that he was the owner.

A Yes.

Q Do you remember who it was?

A No.

Q And then once that was verified then he was released. He was given all his property back.

A Yes.

Q Do you know how this gentleman, this black male gentleman, do you know how he got back to the scene?

A I think I transported him.

Q You took him back to the scene?

A I transported him.

Q If you're not sure, you're not sure.

A I'm not sure. I feel like I was the one that transported him. I'm not 100% sure. I know I went back to the scene to get the Russians. Their vehicle was still there. So I went back to the scene to tow it.

Q So you know you went back to the scene. You just don't know if you transported him back to the scene.

A Yeah I know I went back but I don't know.

Q When this gentleman was at the holding cell, this black male gentleman, the owner, do you remember him complaining of any injuries?

A No.

Q Do you remember any injuries being seen?

A No.

Q Do you remember him complaining of any pain?

A No.

Q Anywhere?

A No, he was good.

Q Do you recall Officer Aledda using any type of excessive force against this gentleman?

A No.

Q At any point? Do you recall if Office Bernadeau was on the scene?

A Yes, he was there.

Q Bernadeau was there. Do you remember if Officer Bernadeau was one of those Officers who was trying to restrain him and put him against the wall?

A I don't remember.

Q You don't remember. And do you...did you witness Officer Bernadeau using any type of force against this gentleman, this black male gentleman?

A No. I don't remember Bernadeau even touching him. I want to say that third Officer was Crespo.

Q Are you sure that it was Crespo or not?

A No I'm not sure.

Q Is there any other information or evidence that you would like to add at this time?

A No.

Q Mr. Calderon, is there anything that I have failed to ask you that you would like to add?

A No.

Q Mr. Calderon, has everything you said been the truth to the best of your knowledge?

A Yes.

Q How long have you been employed with the City of North Miami?

A Twenty-eight years.

Q All as a Law Enforcement Officer?

A No. Four of those years were with Parks and Rec.

Q And what is the station's address?

A 700 N.E. 124 Street.

Q On October 19th, 2013, you responded to 13695 West Dixie Highway as a Backup Officer on an in-progress call. Do you recall this call?

A Yes I do.

Q According to the detail call for service log, it appears you responded in reference to a BURGLARY or a ROBBERY in progress. In your own words, what did you see when you arrived?

A I remember as the call went out there were two different addresses that were going out at the same time. Once Officers determined that it was at the address you gave me, 13695 I responded over there. By the time I responded there they have three people that were being interviewed. One of them was injured and then I remember it being a discussion of whether or not or whose property it actually was. And I know there was a gun involved. That's all I remember right now.

Q Did you arrive with the initial Officers that arrived there or did you arrive after the fact?

A I arrived after the fact.

Q And you arrived after the fact because you were requested as a Supervisor to respond or...

A I just responded to the cal. I must have been coming from further away than the arriving Officers.

Q Who was there when you arrived? Officers? That you can 100% remember.

A I don't recall specifically. All the Officers that ended up there I do remember Brian Becker. That's actually the only one I remember specifically. This was after shift...the new crew shift afternoons that come on. And I don't really recall who else was there without maybe reading some of the reports or anything like that.

Q Now this call went out most likely as either a BURGLARY or a ROBBERY. But it states on the detailed call for service log that it was a ROBBERY, eventually changed to a ROBBERY or left as a ROBBERY. Do you know out of the three people who the victim of the ROBBERY was?

A No I don't.

Q Can you describe the three people for me?

A I remember there was one black male. There were two other males. I think one was Russian or something. I remember there being some kind of language barrier and another gentleman from my recollection.

Q So the other two gentlemen were white?

A Yes.

Q And the one gentleman was black?

A Yes.

Q Do you remember how long you were at the scene for?

A I know I drove on and off to check on their progress cause it was kind of...it took a while to figure out what exactly what was going on. But maybe for 10 minutes at a time to make sure people were secure. And the Fire Rescue came and I came back by. I sat in the parking lot and maybe off and did some report correcting or something to that effect. But on and off for probably an hour or an hour and a half.

Q When you say report correcting, was it correcting this specific report?

A No. I ended up not taking this call. The afternoon Sergeant James Mesidor handled it until it was finished.

Q When you say that you would leave and come back to make sure that people were secure, are we speaking about the three subjects here?

A Well to make sure the Officers were getting down to what exactly happened there. Once everybody...once I felt the scene was secure I didn't need to stay around for them to figure out who was going where. I did make a suggestion that they contact the Detective Bureau and see if they could get some help interviewing.

Q Do you remember if any of these three people that we talked about earlier, the three subjects, the one black male and the two white males, do you remember if they were ever handcuffed? Did you ever see them handcuffed?

A Yeah there were somebody handcuffed cause somebody...one of them I believe it was the black male was in the back of a Patrol car at one point while I was there.

Q Do you know if he was handcuffed while sitting in the back of the Patrol car?

A Although I didn't see it, I'm...from my recollection he must have been handcuffed. Whether I spoke to somebody or I don't believe I ever looked at him.

Q Do you know if he was injured?

A Not to my knowledge.

Q We mentioned...you mentioned somebody being injured, do you remember who that person injured was?

A One of the other guys had his mouth being looked at by Fire Rescue. And then I remember he had high blood pressure or something.

Q Not the guy sitting in the back of the Police...

A Not the guy in the back of the Police car.

Q So Rescue responded?

A Yes.

Q Did you transport anybody?

A No I did not.

Q Did you speak to either or these...any of these three subjects whether the black male or the two?

A I never asked them any questions although I was standing around when Officers were talking about what the situation was. So I may have had some conversation with them but I don't recall anything specific.

Q And based on what you said earlier the situation was most likely the discussion over the ownership of the property, correct?

A From what I recall the two guys were saying they were the property owners or managers. The other guy is saying it was his property and there was some real estate person involved from what I recall from the beginning of the incident.

Q Do you remember if any of these three subjects were transported anywhere?

A I believe they were all taken somewhere whether it was to the station or to a hospital.

Q Do you know who was taken where?

A I believe two of them were brought to the Police station and one of them might have gone to the hospital.

Q The black male went to the hospital or the white male went to the hospital?

A I believe the white male went to the hospital. That's what I remember. I believe he was the one in the back of the fire truck.

Q Do you know who handcuffed the...do you know who...

A I didn't see anybody get handcuffed.

Q So you don't know who handcuffed...

A Later on there was somebody in the back of the car. And again I didn't handle this incident so I don't...I didn't really take notice of very much other than to make sure the scene was secure. I know there was somebody in the back of the car. I know there was a discussion of who was going to go to jail over this. But I didn't see anybody get handcuffed.

Q Did you witness anyone use any type of force whether excessive or not on the scene?

A No.

Q Did you become aware either that day during the incident, afterwards or any other day after that about anyone on that scene using type of force whether excessive or not?

A No.

Q And you said Sergeant Mesidor was the supervisor who eventually handled everything, correct?

A Correct.

Q Do you know what the injury was on the white male?

A I...from what I remember he got hit in the mouth with something.

Q Did you see the injury?

A I saw him...I saw his mouth bleeding.

Q Was there any...was it ever determined how he got the injury in the mouth?

A That I know there was some physical altercation between the two. I don't know...I don't remember exactly.

Q Between what two?

A The black male and him.

Q Did you respond to the station and see these two gentlemen at the station?

A No I did not.

Q Did you assist in verifying ownership of the business?

A No I did not.

Q Did you sign any paperwork having to do with this?

A I don't believe so, no.

Q Did you author any type of supplementary report or any type of supervisor report?

A I don't believe so, no.

Q Is there any other evidence or information that you would like to add at this time?

A No.

Q Mr. Sidd, is there anything that I have failed to ask you that you would like to add to this statement?

A No.

Q Mr. Sidd, has everything that you said been the truth to the best of your knowledge?



Q Did you find the firearm or was the firearm handed to you?

A The firearm was told by the man they had detained, he told us the firearm was in the car and I retrieved the firearm.

Q You retrieved the firearm from the car?

A Yes.

Q Do you remember what kind of car it was?

A I don't remember.

Q Do you remember where the firearm was?

A I believe it was on the front seat. I'm not 100% sure on that though.

Q Okay you don't exactly remember where the firearm was?

A No I don't.

Q Do you remember what the firearm looked like?

A No I don't.

Q Now you said the gentleman that you had detained, do you remember who this gentleman was?

A I didn't get his name. It was a Black Haitian gentleman. That's all I really pretty much know what happened.

Q So it was a black male?

A Yes.

Q And you said he was Haitian?

A Right.

Q How did you know he was Haitian?

A I dubbed the accent.

Q So he had a Haitian accent?

A Correct.

Q According to...I'm sorry you said you had him detained. What does detained mean to you?

A Officers had handcuffs placed on him. When we got the call they came out. He was the subject a 29.

Q What's a 29?

A A ROBBERY.

Q Okay so he was a subject of a ROBBERY?

A Correct.

Q And he was...you said he was in handcuffs?

A Correct.

Q Did you place him in handcuffs?

A No.

Q Who placed him in handcuffs?

A He was already placed in handcuffs by the time I got there.

Q Where was he sitting? Was he standing? Was he sitting?

A He was in a marked Police car.

Q He was in a marked Police car. He was in the back seat of a marked Police car?

A The back seat, yes sir.

Q And how do you know that he was in handcuffs?

A When I went to ask him where the firearm was I saw the handcuffs on him.

Q And he was handcuffed behind his back?

A Correct.

Q Now I'm going to show you the detail...just for the record, I'm referring to the detail call for service report. It says complainant advised that two males walked inside of the business and will not say anything to him or why they're there. Do you have any...you said you responded to gather information. A No. Like I said I got there...I was one of the later ones to get there. I was just coming up a Back up Officer cause I heard there was a firearm on scene.

Q Do you recall other than this ROBBERY subject who is this Haitian black male or a black male with a Haitian accent, do you recall any other subjects?

A They were...I know that other Officers were talking to a white male, two white males that were also on scene.

Q And were they detained?

A When I left, no.

Q How long were you there at the call for?

A Thirty minutes, 45 minutes.

Q The firearm that you checked, you conducted a clearance check on it.

A Correct.

Q What did you do with that firearm?

A It was handed over to the Lead Officer.

Q And who was that?

A I believe to Officer Aledda and I don't know where it went from there.

Q Now do you recall based on the information that you gathered or based on what you saw there, do you recall who the victim was and who the subjects were? Did you ever find out after who the victim was or who the subjects were?

A I never found out.

Q Now you said the two other subjects were white males.

A Correct.

Q Correct and the other one was a black male?

A Correct.

Q And the only one that you saw in handcuffs was the black male.

A Correct.

Q Did you transport anyone?

A No.

Q Do you remember if anybody transported anyone anywhere?

A No that I...I don't know.

A I don't know. I left.

Q Do you recall anyone speaking to you either on the scene or at the station that day or any other day after that about anything having to do with anyone using excessive use of force?

A No.

Q Did you witness anyone using excessive use of force?

A No.

Q Did you see anyone use any type of force?

A No.

Q Did you hear anyone speak either that day or any other day about anyone using any type of force, whether excessive or not?

A No.

Q Okay. Mr. Becker, is there anything that I have failed to ask you that you would like to add at this time?

A No.

A 700 N.E. 124 Street.

Q Okay on October 19th, 2013, you responded to 13695 West Dixie Highway as a Backup Officer on an in-progress call. Do you recall?

A Yes.

Q According to the detail call for service log, it appears you responded in reference to either a BURGLARY or a ROBBERY in progress. Do you remember that?

A Somewhat, yes.

Q Do you remember who the Lead Officer was?

A No.

Q Do you remember who was there?

A A bit shaky. If I remember correctly it was myself. I would like to say Officer Fernandez, Officer Bernadeau.

Q And I want you to only tell me the ones that you're 100% sure about. So Fernandez, you're 100% sure he was there.

A Yes.

Q And Bernadeau, and who else?

A And I want to say Officer Becker.

Q Do you remember what their role was at the call?

A Just Backups.

Q According to the report, two subjects were arrested. Do you recall the arrest?

A No.

Q Do you recall who was arrested?

A No.

Q Do you recall...can you even describe the people who were there who were arrested?

A That were arrested, no. When I arrived on scene we did have a potential subject, if I'm not mistaken. It was a black male. But I'm not aware of his name or his actions at the time.

Q So the black male was a potential?

A Or suspect yes.

Q Or suspect. Do you remember why he was a potential suspect or subject?

A If I'm not mistake I think he was the one that actually had a hand gun. He was armed at the time. So he was placed into custody.

Q So he was armed...now when you say that he was a potential subject, was he a potential subject to you or was it informed to you that he was a potential subject?

A It was informed to me. I responded after the fact.

Q So who informed you that he was a potential subject?

A I don't remember at this time.

Q And when you say that he had a firearm at the time, did you see the firearm?

A No.

Q Okay. Was he ever placed in custody, this person?

A Yes.

Q Was he placed in custody before or after you got there?

A After I got there.

Q After you got there. Do you remember who placed him in custody?

A No.

Q When you say that he was in custody, what does that mean to you?

A I would say he was detained at the moment until further investigation.

Q Was he ever handcuffed?

A I'm not aware.

Q But at the time he was detained?

A Yes.

Q And what does detained mean to you?

A He was placed into the rear seat of a Patrol vehicle.

Q And the rear seat, could you tell whether he was wearing handcuffs or not?

A No.

Q So you don't know whether he was handcuffed or not? You just know that he was detained and he was placed in the back of a Police car.

A I would assume he would be handcuffed but I can't determine for sure if he was or wasn't.

Q Okay and do you know whose Police car he was in?

A No.

Q This gentleman, this black male, can you describe him to me other than the fact that he was a black male?

A No.

Q Do you recall what happened to this black male?

A Just little pieces of it. I remember when I arrived, I came after the fact. I just asked a few questions. I remember talking to what at the time was the alleged victim, which there were two white males. And if I'm not mistaken they were saying that they were trying to work at the business. And that they were working for the owner of the business. And that the black male claimed to have been the owner. And they got into some sort of dispute, physical dispute.

Q A physical dispute?

A Yes.

Q Did they have any injuries?

A Not that I remember.

Q Do you know if the black male had any injuries?

A Not that I remember. Actually yes, the one white male did have injuries to the mouth and Rescue did respond.

Q What injury did he have?

A If I'm not mistaken, I think it was a busted lip.

Q A busted lip?

A Yes.

Q Did you see this injury?

A Yes.

Q Or are you just aware of the injury?

A I was aware of the injury.

Q You didn't see the injury?

A Rescue responded and I saw a little bit of blood coming from the alleged victims' mouth. So I'm assuming it was a busted lip.

Q Did you transport anyone?

A No.

Q Did you handcuff anyone?

A No.

Q Do you remember who transported who and where?

A No.

Q Do you recall Officer Aledda or Officer Bernadeau handcuffing, arresting or transporting anyone regarding this incident?

A Not that I'm aware. I know that they may have been there but I don't know who was Primary or who handcuffed anyone.

Q The original call was dispatched at 3:36 P.M. and you were dispatched at 3:45 P.M., so it's about a 10 minute difference.

A Okay.

Q Was additional...did you respond because additional Backup was requested, did you respond because you just thought that they may need someone? Or were you dispatched by Communications there?

A At this time I don't remember. I may have just responded just to respond for extra support in case they needed me.

Q Okay so other than basically stand around for additional support, do you remember anything else that you may have done on the scene?

A Yes.

Q What else did you do?

A I stood by...myself and Officer Fernandez to secure the business. If I'm not mistaken, we waited for the owner's son to come secure the business because the door was open and we didn't want anyone to come in and break into the business. So we stood by until someone can secure the business.

Q When you say the owner's son, are we talking about the son of the black male that was...

A It was later revealed that the owner or alleged owner of the business was in fact the black male who claimed to have just bought the business. And his son was the one that came over and secured it.

Q So the black male son is the one that came and secured the business, okay. And when you say it was later learned, do you remember how it was learned that he was the owner of the business?

A I think, if I'm not mistaken...I don't know if it was myself or Officer Fernandez that received a phone call. It could have been myself. I'm not sure if it was a phone call by Bernadeau or Aleda saying that the son was going to come and secure the business.

Q The son of the black male?

A Yes.

Q And that's how it was revealed to you that the black male was actually the owner?

A Yes.

Q Other than standing by at the business and observing what you observed, was there anything else or any other role that you played at the incident on this call?

A No. Other than just securing the business until someone came to secure was my only role in it.

Q Do you remember how they secured the business?

A If I'm not mistaken, I think they tried to put a chain and padlock on it. I'm not really sure. Once the son responded we basically just left it in his hands from there, from what I recall.

Q Is there any other information or evidence that you would like to add at this time?

A No.

Q Has anyone made any comments to you regarding excessive use of force used by anyone at this scene on that day ever since that day until today? Had anyone made any comments to you about excessive force being used by any Officer there?

A No.

Q Mr. Crespo, is there anything that I have failed to ask you that you would like to add to the statement at this time?

A No.

Q Mr. Crespo, has everything you said been the truth to the best of your knowledge?

A Yes.
