Weapons, Explosives Stockpiling by White Supremacists Rampant Across U.S. in 1993

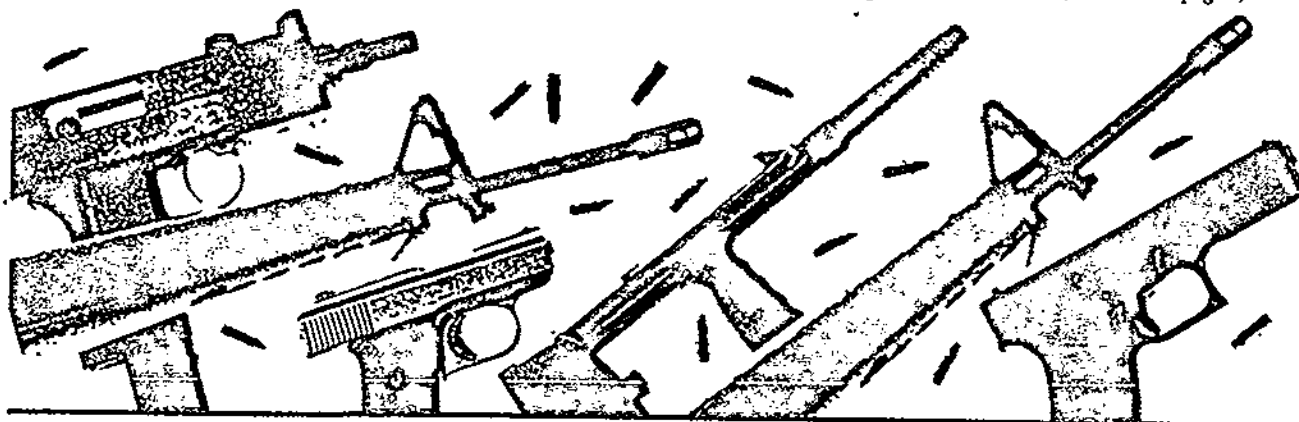
Bombing Plots Threaten Wave of Terrorism

Law enforcement agencies thwarted a potential wave of terrorism in 1993 with the arrests of 35 suspected white supremacists in 13 states on explosives and weapons charges.

The discovery of six weapons arsenals, 13 explosives stockpiles and various bombing plots apparently interrupted a series of planned attacks that could have created havoc nationwide, said Klanwatch Director Danny Welch. "Creating racial turmoil is no longer a white supremacist fantasy but a real threat to the nation when hate groups start engaging in terrorism."

Social turmoil created in 1993 when white supremacists succeeding in carrying out a string of attacks shows the destructive potential of terrorism against racial, religious and other minorities.

Although many white supremacists have long been interested in stockpiling weapons and have talked about starting a race war for years, the multiple concrete efforts to carry out such a plan through high-profile attacks on minorities are a new development. Klanwatch documented only a handful of white supremacists arrested for stockpiling explosives and weapons in 1992. (continued on page 2)



Klanwatch Report: Violent Hate Crime Remains At Record Levels Nationwide

Deadly hate violence remained at record levels nationwide in 1993 for the second consecutive year.

Although some types of bias crimes were down last year, the overall picture matched that of 1992—the deadliest and most

violent year Klanwatch has tracked in its 15-year history.

Klanwatch's hate crime report for 1993 documents 30 bias homicides, a figure that is almost the same as the 31 hate murders counted in 1992. The number of bias motivated

assaults in 1993 was also approximately the same as the number of assaults reported in 1992. Since 1990 Klanwatch has documented 108 murders motivated by hatred and hundreds of bias-motivated assaults.

MINORITIES TARGETED IN PLOTS

The intercepted bombing plots and terrorism included:

■ A neo-Nazi's plan to bomb the National Afro-American Museum in Wilberforce, Ohio on Martin Luther King Day. An undercover agent with the U.S. Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms posing as a Ku Klux Klan member selling weapons and explosives foiled the plot.

■ The manufacture of pipe bombs and stockpiling of weapons by a suspected white supremacist in Kenner, La. in April. Bombs were discovered in nearby Metairie the day before the suspect's arrest.

■ Two white residents' alleged plan to plant bombs at the homes of black neighbors in a public housing project in Toledo, Ohio. The suspected white supremacists engaged in a shootout with police and federal authorities during a raid in May that uncovered handguns, knives and materials to make bombs.

■ A plan to blow up the First African Methodist Episcopal Church in Los Angeles and to spray members of the 8,500-member congregation with machine gun fire. The plot also called for attacks on Rodney King, black celebrities and Jewish targets. Eight white supremacists linked to the Church of the Creator and the White Aryan Resistance either pleaded guilty to or were convicted on federal charges after an FBI sting uncovered the conspiracy in July.

STOCKPILING INCREASES

The weapons arrests in 1993 show that white supremacists are continuing

to stockpile large quantities of arms and explosives in preparation for a great race war that some hate groups warn will erupt in the country in the near future.

The weapons and explosives arsenals discovered by law enforcement agencies included:

■ The manufacture of hundreds of pipe bombs by three white sepa-

rate machine guns to undercover federal firearms officers.

■ About 100 guns found in April in the Boston apartment of a veteran constable who had a collection of Nazi memorabilia and a photograph of himself holding a Nazi flag.

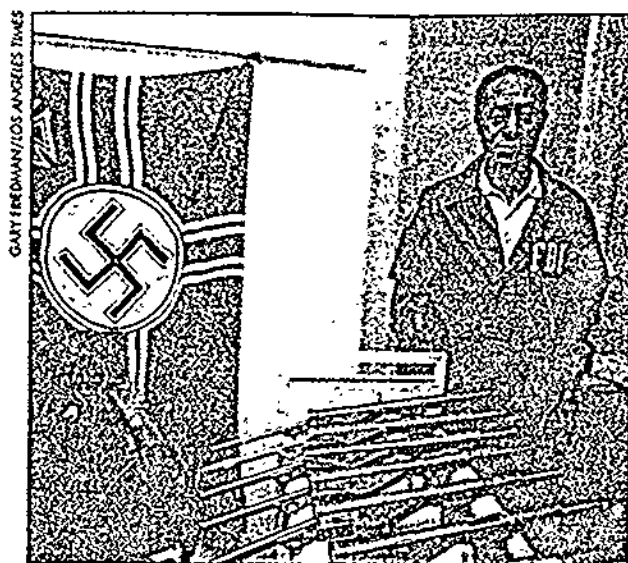
Even young white supremacists such as the violence-prone Skinhead groups have access to a wide variety of sophisticated arms. Police have confiscated semi-automatic assault rifles and handguns and large quantities of ammunition from Skinheads. Monitoring groups report that younger white supremacists routinely carry automatic weapons and rifles at private rallies.

A General Accounting Office (GAO) report released in November indicated that lax inventory controls are allowing military machine guns, grenades and other equipment to fall into the hands of white supremacists. Department of Defense personnel reportedly

are stealing weapons and parts that can be used to upgrade semi-automatic weapons to fully-automatic ones.

Military weapons from the old Soviet Union, other eastern European nations, the Mideast and Latin America countries are being sold in the international arms market and may be falling into the hands of white supremacists. The efforts of American white supremacists to establish closer ties to hate groups in other countries may facilitate the exchange of weapons.

Law enforcement agencies and others monitoring white supremacist groups report that Canadian Church of

ratists in Pueblo, Colo. in the fall. Agents with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms said the chemicals were so dangerous that merely mixing them threatened lives.

■ About 5,000 rounds of ammunition and three firearms stockpiled by a Newnan, Ga. couple who were linked by police in October to associates involved in a militant fax network that unites tax protesters, white supremacists and radical right wing revolutionaries.

■ Thirteen rifles and handguns found in March in the home of a Ku Klux Klan member in Middle River, Md. who had illegally sold rifles and

Thank you for your prompt response and your assistance in this matter. I also appreciate your willingness to discreetly provide further assistance with regard to the sizing and distribution of that shoe.

I have enclosed six photographs which depict the shoe impression. The heel-to-toe dimensions in inches and millimeters are drawn onto two of those photographs. Although estimates can be made of the size of the shoes based on heel-to-toe measurements, the most accurate determination would be with direct physical comparison with samples from the different molds in that size range. To that extent, my goal would be to obtain through you from SILGA in Italy those samples, both left and right as well as the answers from SILGA to the following questions:

1. How many molds exist for the larger size range, such as size 10 and higher? Is it possible to obtain a sample of each?
2. Can an outsole from one mold be used interchangeably on more than one size shoe; i.e. can a size 12 molded outsole be used on any other size than size 12?
3. What is the method of construction; i.e. compression molded unit sole glued and/or stitched to lasted upper?
4. What is the origin and age of the design? Has it ever been used on other shoes? If so, which shoes and when?

In addition, could you please provide the formal name and address of SILGA.

As we previously discussed, I am also attempting to obtain information regarding the distribution of the shoe and the dates it has been in sold in this country.

For purposes of covering investigative leads, it would be of great assistance to have photographs of the shoes as well as the knowledge of the various combinations of upper colors and styles it was produced with. To that extent, are there any shoe stores in the Washington, D. C. metropolitan area which may still have these? If not, would there be any advertisements depicting those shoes or would it be possible to borrow a shoe or shoes to photograph?

Again, your assistance is greatly appreciated.

Please allow me to introduce myself. My name is [REDACTED] and I am a Special Agent of the FBI. I work in the FBI Laboratory in Washington, D.C. I am examining evidence in a very serious multiple homicide. At the scene of that crime, many footwear impressions of the perpetrator were left in blood. I have determined that the shoe design is a BRUNI-MAGLI design made by SILGA of Italy. A copy of a couple of the many impressions is being transmitted. I have been in touch with [REDACTED] of the BRUNI MAGLI/UMA Shoe Company in Carlstadt, New Jersey. He is aware of the importance of the case and I believe he has provided you with several questions concerning that shoe design. Due to the time limitations on this case and the possibility of additional important questions arising, I have asked [REDACTED] if I might fax this letter to you directly and he has consented to that.

I wish to determine, as accurately as possible, and hopefully, with 100% accuracy, the exact shoe size of the shoe that left the impressions in blood at the crime scene. I am very familiar with footwear manufacturing methods and I know that if I had access to and/or samples of the molds of this design, I would be able to determine that size. I would also need to discuss the manufacturing methods utilized in the production of these shoes, the method of mold manufacturing of the molds (CAD-CAM vs. hand milled) the sizing system used, other names the shoe was sold under, whether close sizes such as size 12 and 13, could be interchanged, and so forth. Thank you for your letter of Sept. 5, 1994 with the additional sizing information. I have received sole samples in sizes 42 through 47 from SILGA. The size 46 (U.S. size 12) matched left and right impressions perfectly. For that reason and due to your help, I will not be traveling to Italy as planned, at this time. I have notified SILGA of this.

I do have some additional questions that perhaps are best answered by you and "4C." Does "4C" have any drawings or other documentation that relates the size of a foot to a size 46 or US size 12, as the basis for conversion of a size 46 to a 12? Would they ever have used a size 46 outsole on a size 11 1/2 or size 13? Also, is there any color pictures or small sample of leather that represents the "olive" color of the Bruni Magli shoes sold in this country, since there are no longer any of those shoes available?

There is one other question or problem that is very important. [Redacted] is pursuing this at SILGA when he visits them next week, but it may be something to ask you as well. As far as you can determine, were there any other U2887 outsoles sold in the U.S. other than the Bruni Magli shoes?

I am on receipt of your fax of Sept. 9, 1994. Concerning the additional questions I have inquired with 4C

1) There are no drawings or other documentation that relates the size of a foot size 46/12. It is the factory of the lasts that supplies finished lasts that are prepared and graded according some internal standards.

Anyway I am sending you herewith the copy of one table of shoes scale comparison that I got from factories of lasts perhaps you can find something interesting for you.

In addition we could ship you 1 pr of lasts size 12 that "4C" used to last the shoes built with sole U2887; if you think it is convenient please advise.

2) As a rule "4C" should not have lasted size 46 outsoles on lasts size 11 1/2 or 13; anyway this could happen but occasionally and on exceptional cases; i.e. when at the end of the production of a series of shoes they have 1 pair of upper size 12 and no soles size 46 left. At this point factory could have used 1 pair of outsoles size 45 or 47 and last them on a 12. But I emphasize that this could occur very very occasionally. It is impossible to know today how many times this can happen because there are no records for these things.

3) Olive color

Messrs "4C" have sent you by registered airmail a small reference of the color/material that has been used for the shoes with the sole U2887. Unfortunately this is only a small piece of leather because that is the only piece left in the factory.

4) SILGA have not supplied yet the additional list of the 1990 shoe factories promised at the beginning for last friday and then for yesterday. Maybe you can have ask for it.....he may have more success.

I have been assisting a police department in the examination of shoe impressions in a very serious multiple homicide. I have learned that the outsole pattern, a copy of which is attached, is made by SILGA at your factory under several different names. How many molds exist for the larger sizes and would I be able to obtain a sample molding of each?

Are all of the original molds for this design still available or have some of them been replaced, broken or destroyed?

Were the molds "hand milled" or were they produced with a CAD-CAM method?

Is the molding method Unit Compression Molding?

The soles of the design you are interested in are produced with the single compression technology in cast -or as you say "hand milled"- molds. We have one mold for each size from 35 to 47, all molds are the original ones, with which we started production in Jan. 1990, they were produced -as usual- by our mold maker.

As you state uppers/lasts of more than one size can be used in connection to one size sole, in this particular case, we believe that uppers/lasts of size 11 could have been used with soles 44 and 45 while our bigger sole, size 47, could have been used with your size 13 or 14.

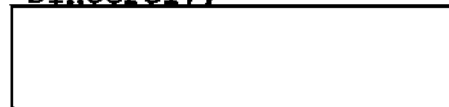

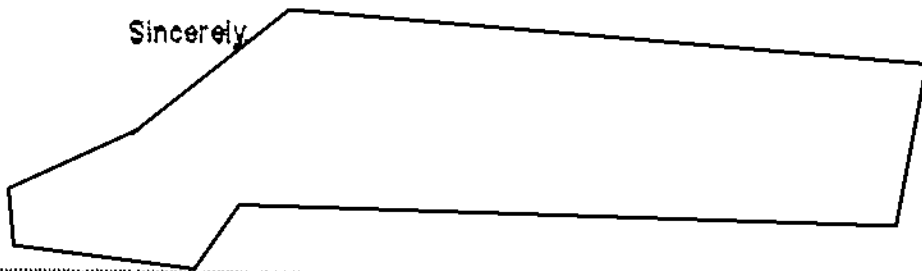

In reviewing the five-page print-out you faxed here last week, listing buyers of article U2887 soles from S.I.L.G.A. GOMMA, Italy, since 1990, there appear to be five dominant companies.

During this period, customers 93 and 94, controlled by the same ownership, purchased 14002 pairs of these soles. Customer 806 bought 13573 pairs and customers 1254, 1046, and 1439 are listed as having bought 6291, 6212, and 3909 pairs, respectively. Of this group, you have already been provided with addresses for customers 93, 94, and 1439. Perhaps you might contact these manufacturers as well as the other three whose addresses you do not have yet.

While eight factories are identified as having bought this sole from January 1991 through July 1994, there is no indication of quantities involved. This information, and their addresses, might prove to be meaningful.

With a fax that will be sent to S.I.L.G.A. GOMMA later today, I will include this message so that they are aware that you might possibly ask for additional information relative to your investigation.

As far as we know, no shipment of articles with this type of sole was made to the United States of America, nor was any such article sold separately to an American gentleman.

We also checked and made sure that no deliveries were made to European customers; accordingly, we can state that footwear with this U-2887-sole model was sold only to Italian stores, for use with shoes of Italian taste for Italian fashion.

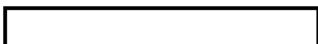

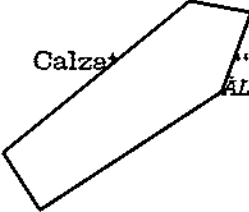
