RE-ENACTMENT OF ENCOUNTER WITH THREE WHITE MALES

FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

Date of transcription June 19, 1980

On Tuesday evening, June 17, 1980, at approximately 10:30 PM, the situation wherein [] and Vernon Jordan encountered three white males near the intersection of Clinton and Coldwater Road, Fort Wayne, Indiana, was reenacted with the express purpose of determining if those three white males could have followed the Jordan vehicle and been responsible for the shooting of Mr. Jordan.

Special Agent [] and Special Clerk [] [] drove at a normal rate of speed northbound on Coldwater Road, and Special Agents [] and [] followed in a separate vehicle. At the intersection of Clinton and Coldwater, Special Agent [] veered off to the right and, thereafter, cut through a business parking lot and returned to the northbound lane of Coldwater Road. From that vantage point, it was possible to follow Special Agent [] at a normal rate of speed and at a distance of approximately one to two blocks. Both cars encountered green lights up to Washington Center Road. At Washington Center Road, [] vehicle was in the left, westbound turn lane, and [] vehicle was parked directly beside them in the northbound lane of Coldwater. [] vehicle was clearly visible to pull into the driveway entrance of the Marriott, travel in front of the Marriott, and eventually park at the northeast corner where [] car had been parked. Special Agent [] vehicle paralleled the travels of Special Agent [] car and was in plain view at all times. [] car, thereafter, proceeded northbound over I-69, made a turn-around at an unknown street (Special Agent [] car had to wait for passing traffic before he could enter onto Coldwater Road southbound). Southbound on Coldwater Road, [] thereafter, entered onto the entrance ramp to I-69 for the northbound lane of traffic. Approximately halfway through that cloverleaf curve, [] vehicle was parked and from there a clear view of [] car was possible. Special Agent [] and Special Agent [] thereafter exited the vehicle, crossed through the depression that separates the off-bound ramp from the on-bound ramp, to a distance of about 150 yards. At that location, Special Agent [] was in a position to simulate the position of the individual who shot Mr. Jordan. Having obtained that position, Special Agent [] waited for a short length of time then discontinued any other enactment and walked across the street, crossed the fence, and talked with Special Agent []

INVESTIGATION CONCERNING THREE WHITE MALES

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The following investigation was conducted at Fort Wayne, Indiana, regarding three white males who were seen on May 29, 1980, in the vicinity of Coldwater Road and North Clinton Road, Fort Wayne, Indiana:

On June 9, 1980, a dark green, two-door, 1969 Chevrolet Caprice, was observed exiting [redacted], Fort Wayne, Indiana. The vehicle was being driven by a lone white female and bore 1980 Indiana License [redacted]. The vehicle was a two-door coupe which had a black vinyl top and a damaged left side door.

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The vehicle was determined to belong to [redacted], who resides at [redacted]. [redacted] was contacted regarding the incident which occurred on the morning of May 29, 1980, at the intersection of North Clinton and Coldwater Road, but could offer no information about the matter.

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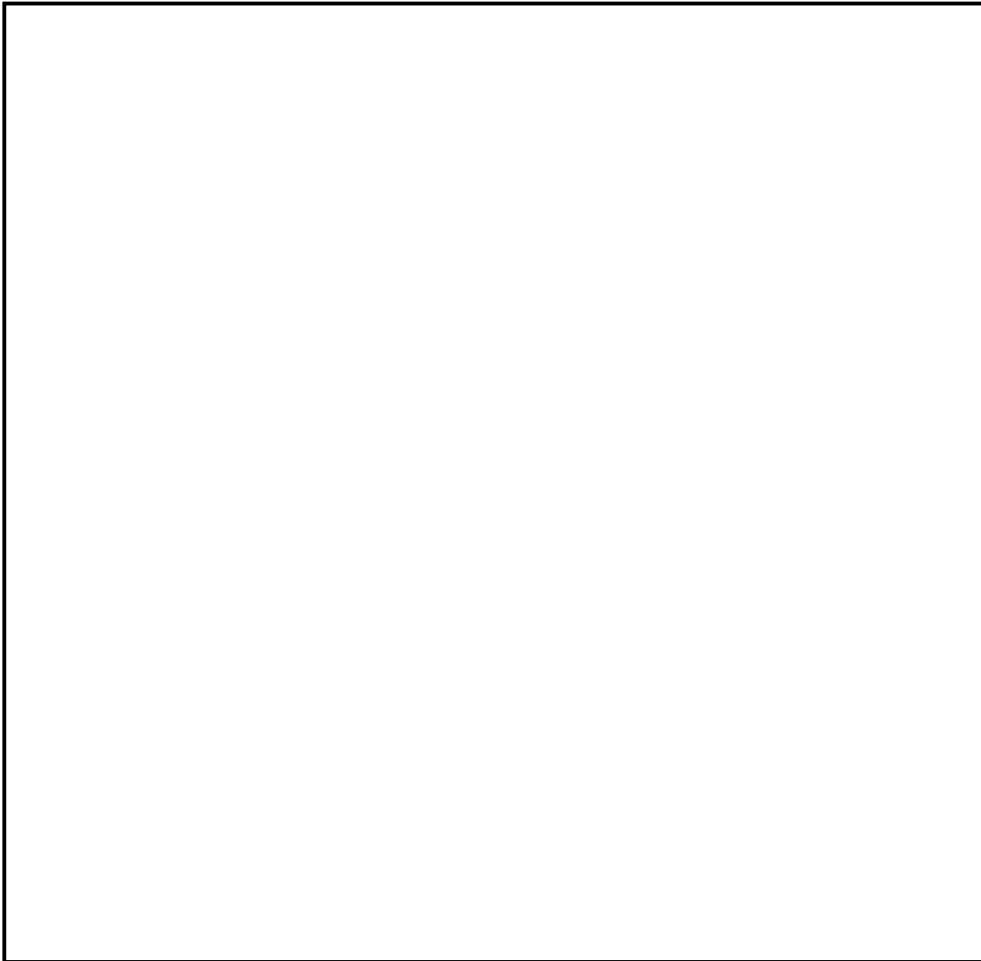
On June 10, 1988, Special Agent [redacted] contacted the following individuals at Fort Wayne, Indiana, in the vicinity of the reported location of three white males seen in a dark sedan on May 29, 1980, with negative results:

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[redacted] said that there are three young white males who live [redacted] She gave their names as [redacted] She advised that [redacted] owns an old black Chevrolet. She said that she doubts if any of them own a rifle.

On May 30, 1980, the Fort Wayne Police Department received an anonymous call stating three white males were seen in a 1965 white Chevrolet, two-door, bearing Tennessee License near Butler Road, in Fort Wayne.

By communication dated June 20, 1980, the Knoxville, Tennessee, Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation advised as follows:

On June 19, 1980, [redacted] was interviewed at Morgan County, Tennessee. [redacted] advised he owns a 1966 white Chevrolet, displaying Tennessee License Plate [redacted]. [redacted] worked in the Fort Wayne, Indiana, area from March to June 4 or 5, 1980, for Nup-Simms Cable TV Company. While in Fort Wayne, [redacted] resided at [redacted]
[redacted]

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[redacted] recalls being alone at a Fort Wayne restaurant, the Country Kitchen (Washington Center Road, one mile east of the Marriott), at the time of the shooting.

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It should be noted that [redacted] place of residence in Fort Wayne and the location provided by the anonymous caller are in close proximity.

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On June 20, 1980, [redacted] Fort Wayne, Indiana, Telephone Number [redacted], was interviewed regarding information which he may have concerning a vehicle seen occupied by three white males on the evening of May 28, 1980. [redacted] advised as follows:

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[redacted] stated that as he was driving home on the evening of May 28, 1980, between 10:00 and 10:30 PM, he observed an early 1970's-type, possibly a 1972, Chevrolet occupied by three white males whom he believed to be in their late teens or early 20's. [redacted] advised that these individuals yelled something out of their window at four black males who were riding in a Continental. [redacted] advised that this incident occurred at the intersection of Lake Avenue and Reed Road. [redacted] related that after the incident, the 1972 Chevrolet left the scene at a high rate of speed, traveling north on Reed to either Mathias Street or Monarch Street. [redacted] advised that he observed this same vehicle running two red lights, one at the corner of Trier and Maplecrest and the other at the corner of Highway 37 and Maplecrest. [redacted] advised that the vehicle turned north onto Highway 37 and headed north. [redacted] described the vehicle as having a dark green bottom with a light-colored top. He stated that the three individuals were in their late teens or early 20's and were situated such that two were sitting in the front seat while the third was in the rear seat. [redacted] advised that because he was aware that Jordan was in town, he was afraid that something may come of the incident described above; therefore, he believes he wrote down the license number of the Chevrolet, but cannot locate this at the present time. He advised that the Indiana plate had a [redacted] prefix, but could not recall any of the other numbers. [redacted] advised that he will contact the Federal Bureau of Investigation if he can locate the paper on which he wrote the number.

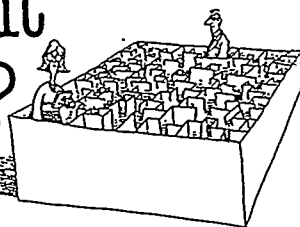

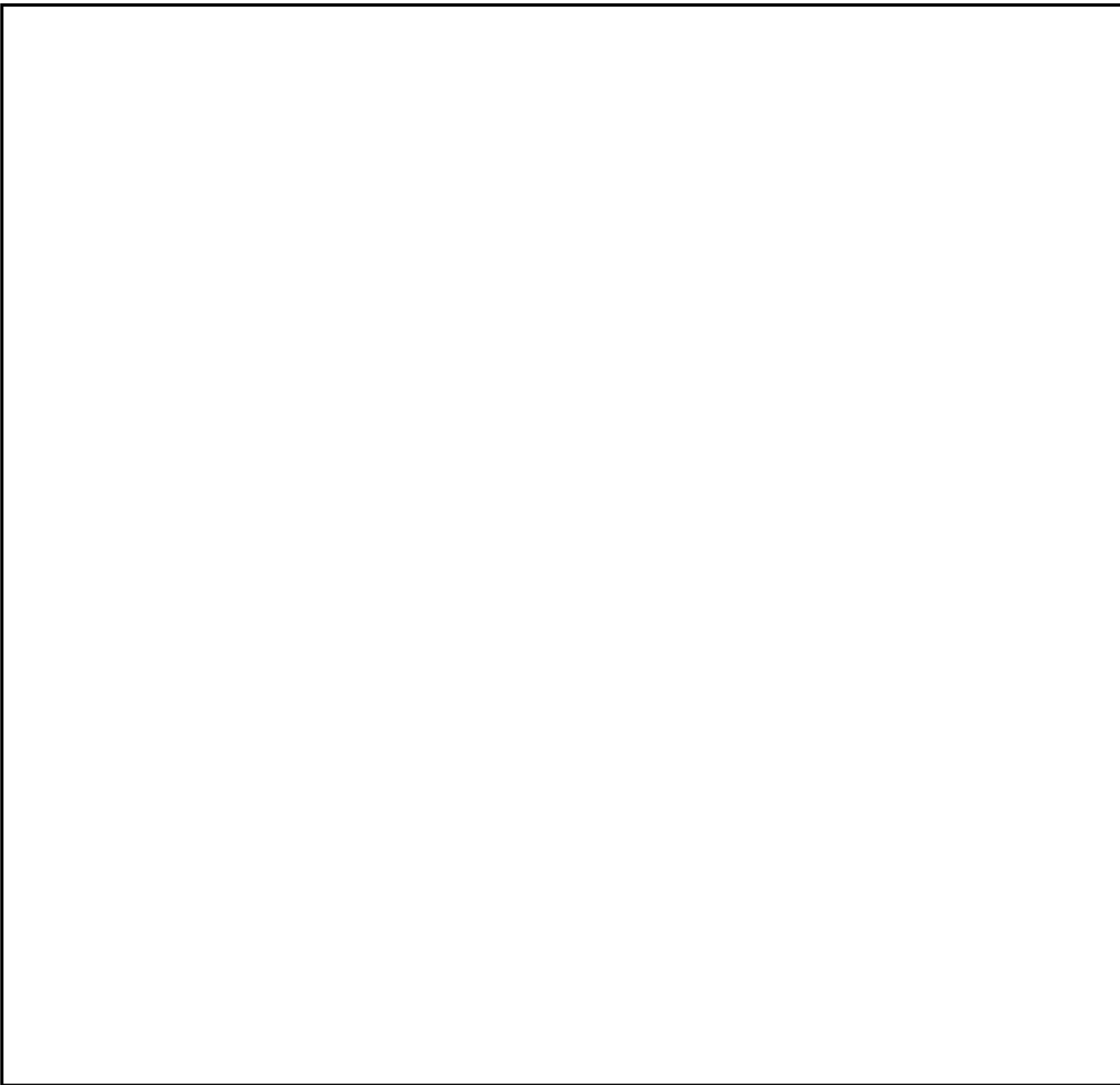

Allegation II: Complaint of Sexual Discrimination Filed at the U.S. Equal Employee and Opportunity Commission (EEOC)

[redacted], Arlington, Virginia, advised [redacted]
[redacted] was asked how and to whom an AGSHF employee would make a complaint such as sexual harassment. She stated [redacted]

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[redacted] She described AGSHF as "an old Texas law firm" wherein some lewd remarks were occasionally overheard. The firm is perceived by some as "male chauvinist" and that "several" have left because of that. She emphasized that Mr. Jordan was **not** one who was perceived as a chauvinist, that he "could always be complimentary to a woman, but he did not cross over the line of professionalism."

[redacted] advised any complainant might speak to his or her individual supervisor, to [redacted], to [redacted], or to [redacted]. [redacted] advised [redacted] would be the ultimate individual to hear such official complaints, and that he "would not lie to you." [redacted] said that a complaint that a man complimented a woman on her looks, used words like "foxy" or "sexy" might not get very far before it would be dropped or allowed to die. However, she stated she'd be surprised if the management would ignore a complaint about someone fondling himself or asking for dates, "no matter who it was. Vernon or not." She explained that Mr. Jordan wears a back brace to support damaged muscles since his shooting. She suggested that from time to time, he might become uncomfortable, be seen adjusting the brace, his shirt and trousers, which she speculated might be mistaken for something else. She characterized Mr. Jordan as happily married.

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[redacted] Washington, D.C., advised he has known Mr. Jordan for approximately [redacted] years professionally and socially. He stated that within the last year, an individual he described as disgruntled with AGSHF

alleged Mr. Jordan had sexual harassed her. He believed that person filed charges with the District of Columbia Human Rights Office (DCHRO) which stated that Mr. Jordan had made suggestive and/or explicit sexual comments to her. [] stated the allegations were investigated and dismissed. [] further stated that Mr. Jordan specializes in employment and equal opportunity law, shows tremendous judgment, and is a charismatic, outgoing, friendly individual.

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[] Washington, D.C., was asked if there was anything concerning Mr. Jordan which could be potentially embarrassing, should it become public at a later date. Other than the complaint of sexual harassment mentioned by [] (mentioned above), [] did not furnish any additional matters. He characterized that as a totally baseless claim, which had been investigated and dismissed, and he stated that []

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[] He stated he would have only complimentary remarks, and no derogatory information concerning Mr. Jordan. [] advised he has the highest regard for Mr. Jordan, and he considers him professional, responsible, dedicated and honest.

(It was determined that this matter was not investigated by DCHRO, but by the United States Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC). Also see the Agency Checks section of this summary memorandum for the disposition of the EEO complaint.)

[] Washington, D.C., commented favorably concerning Mr. Jordan and advised she has never heard any allegations of sexual harassment by Mr. Jordan. She said he gets along with his subordinates. [] has known Mr. Jordan professionally for [] years.

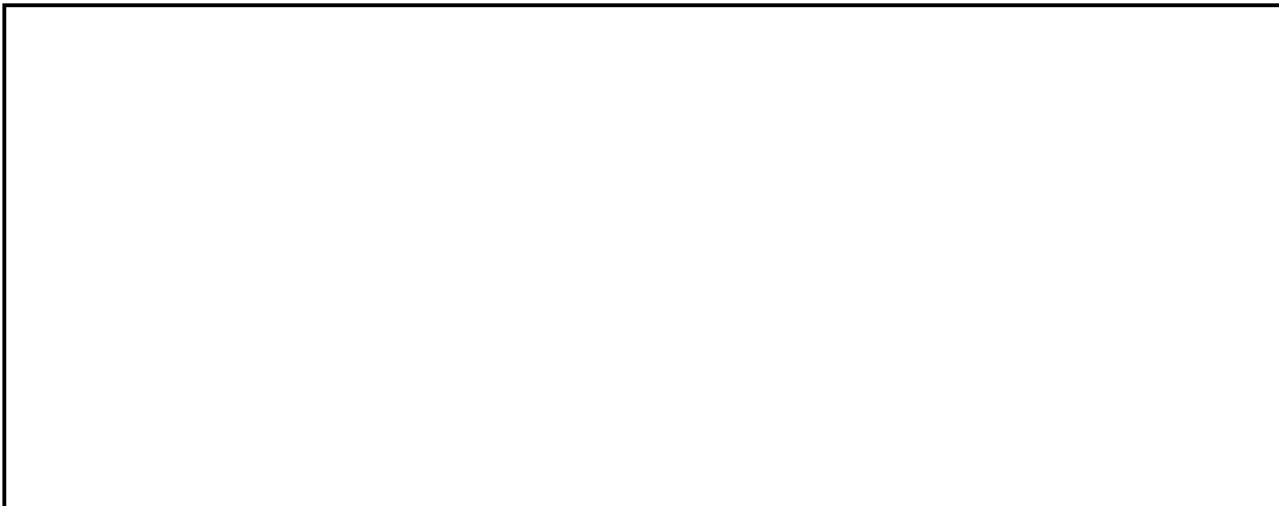

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[redacted] advised he has known Mr. Jordan approximately [redacted] years. He stated that [redacted] had filed a complaint with EEOC against AGSHF, as a whole, and the complaint named Mr. Jordan in part. [redacted]

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[redacted] Mr. Jordan flatly denied the allegations. The EEOC issued a "no cause determination" concerning all charges on August 21, 1992. [redacted] provided copies of the EEOC investigation to the FBI.

[redacted] Washington, D.C., advised she has known Mr. Jordan approximately [redacted] years professionally. She advised [redacted] She stated that Mr. Jordan is popular with and respected by the support staff because he does not treat them in a demeaning manner and treats them as intelligent individuals. She was aware of the complainant who filed an EEOC complaint, which included Mr. Jordan, and stated the specific allegations were that Mr. Jordan referred to the complainant's "prettiness" and had "asked to see some thigh." [redacted] characterized the complainant as being "paranoid," who also complained about mistreatment from other individuals.

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[redacted] was recontacted and asked to comment if she had ever heard of sexual harassment complaints from any female employee. She responded she had not. She was asked if she had ever told the EEO complainant to do "whatever Mr. Jordan wants," which she denied. [redacted] had not heard of sexual harassment, indiscretions, or improper behavior by Mr. Jordan.

[redacted] advised she has known Mr. Jordan personally and professionally since [redacted]. She advised she knew nothing negative concerning him, that he treats her as an equal rather than a subordinate, and that she has the utmost respect for him.

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[redacted] was recontacted. She stated that Mr. Jordan had told her of sexual harassment allegations raised by the EEO complainant. She stated the complainant had never complained to her about Mr. Jordan asking for dates. She was unaware of any problems any females had had with Mr. Jordan. She stated Mr. Jordan has never sexually harassed her or displayed any inappropriate indiscrete behavior.

[REDACTED] and twenty-five additional persons, consisting of current and former colleagues, supervisors, coworkers, neighbors, references, professional associates, and social acquaintances, were interviewed. They provided favorable comments concerning Mr. Jordan's character, associates, reputation, and loyalty. They stated they are unaware of any illegal drug use or alcohol abuse by Mr. Jordan, nor have they ever known him to exhibit any type of bias or prejudice against any class of citizen or any type of religious, racial or ethnic group. They also commented that they believe Mr. Jordan lives within his financial means. They recommended him for a position of trust and responsibility.

Financial Responsibility

A search of the computerized records of Equifax Credit Information Services, Atlanta, Georgia, conducted at FBI Headquarters in December, 1992, disclosed no pertinent information concerning Mr. Jordan.

Law Enforcement Agency Checks

Information has been received from appropriate law enforcement agencies indicating their files contain no record concerning Mr. Jordan.

Bar Affiliations

Mr. Jordan is eligible to practice law in the District of Columbia and Arkansas. According to information available, no grievances have been filed against him.

Miscellaneous

A search of NEXIS, a computerized news retrieval service, disclosed no pertinent information concerning Mr. Jordan.

Mr. Jordan advised that subsequent to his well-publicized assassination attempt in 1980, [REDACTED]

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Agency Checks

A check of records of EEOC disclosed the complaint mentioned under the Interviews section of this summary memorandum. In July, 1991, a complaint of discrimination was filed against AGSHF by a former AGSHF employee. The complainant

alleged that a female coworker played practical jokes on the her, that she was told by a female coworker to "show some thigh" to a female supervisor in order to "get along," and that she (the complainant) was repeatedly asked out (once or twice a month) and complimented on her appearance by Mr. Jordan. On August 21, 1992, EEOC issued a determination that the evidence obtained during the investigation did not find that the complainant's allegations constituted harassment on the basis of sex. (The determination stated that the complainant's only subsequent course of action would be a lawsuit filed within 90 days of receipt of the determination letter.)

As part of the aforementioned complaint, it was alleged that [] and [] (see Interviews section) were witnesses inasmuch as they had been advised of sexual harassment. It was alleged they were aware Mr. Jordan asked the complainant out on dates and had commented on the complainant's appearance. On August 19-20, 1992, EEOC interviewed [] and [] and asked if complaints of sexual harassment by Mr. Jordan were lodged with them, if they were aware Mr. Jordan had asked the complainant out on dates and commented on her appearance. Both [] and [] responded negatively to these questions.

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Mr. Jordan was interviewed by EEOC on August 20, 1992, and provided the following: (Some of Mr. Jordan's statements have been excerpted by the FBI only because they would identify the complainant, who has been interviewed by the FBI and who requested and has been granted confidentiality by the FBI.)

"I never asked (complainant) out on a date. I never commented on (complainant's) appearance. I never sexually harassed (complainant). To be honest, I did not even know who she was until (the law firm) came to me about the charge. I never knew her last name until then. I never really spoke with her except on one occasion, she came up to me and told me...I may have ridden down on the elevator with her on one occasion too....I can tell you honestly, without fear of contradiction, that I never made any advances, sexually or otherwise, towards

(complainant). I am not a perfect man, but I can tell you that I am not a fool. I am one of the senior partners in the firm, and I am not about to throw all of that away."

At approximately 11:35am, Mr. VERNON EULION JORDAN, Jr., the appointee in this matter, contacted the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) office. He was thereupon queried with respect to: 1.) the duration of time he underwent psychiatric counseling following a 1980 shooting incident in which he was the victim; and, 2.) his compensated and non-compensated memberships on corporate boards and non-corporate, but community-oriented organizations. Mr. JORDAN provided the following information.

Mr. JORDAN advised that after he was shot he underwent psychiatric counseling for approximately three (3) months to ensure that there was no trauma as an aftereffect. Mr. JORDAN stated that he was sure that this counseling came to a conclusion before Christmas, 1980. Mr. JORDAN was queried as to whether any residual or parallel emotional problems had been discovered, to which he responded in the negative. He repeated that the counseling he had received was routine to ensure that there would be no post-shooting trauma; or, at least to predict the likelihood of any trauma for early treatment purposes.

Mr. JORDAN advised that the psychiatrist asked him questions such as, "did you hate your mother and father?"; but, the sessions were not "couch" sessions.

Mr. JORDAN was able to recall only the first name of the psychiatrist, which he said was [redacted]. Mr. JORDAN visited [redacted] in his office on the tenth (10th) floor at 71st and Madison, the Northeast corner of the intersection, New York, New York. Mr. JORDAN recalled that the psychiatrist was Austrian. Mr. JORDAN advised that he has no reason to believe that this psychiatrist has terminated his practice at this location.

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Mr. JORDAN advised that his secretary, [redacted] would provide the desired information regarding his organizational memberships; and, he would retrieve the last name of the doctor overnight.

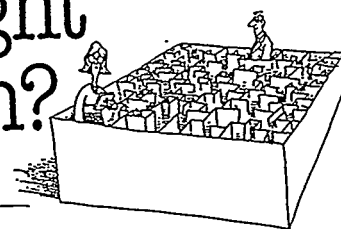
