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Man named in Brittane Drexel case arrested for violating conditions of release in unrelated robbery case

CHARLESTON, SC (WMBF) – A man who has been accused of being involved in the 2009 disappearance of Brittane Drexel is due in court Wednesday for allegedly violating the conditions of his release for an unrelated 2011 robbery case.

Timothy Da'Shawn Taylor will be in federal court in Charleston at 1:30 p.m. Wednesday for a hearing regarding a violation of his pre-trial release, according to court records.

Documents show that on October 21, 2017, at 9:30 p.m., an officer received an alert that Taylor's location monitoring showed he was not at his home. His probation officer looked at Taylor's logged GPS points to determine that he had gone to the Dorchester Dragway on Saturday night. He did not have permission to be at that location, and Taylor later admitted that he was at the dragway working on one of his vehicles.

On October 27, a warrant was issued to arrest Taylor for failing to comply with the conditions of his home detention.

Taylor's detention is for a 2011 armed robbery of a fast food restaurant. Back in July of this year, Taylor pleaded guilty to federal charges related to the 2011 armed robbery. Taylor reportedly had confessed to being the getaway driver in the robbery of a Mount Pleasant McDonald's. He was awaiting sentencing on this case when he allegedly violated the conditions of his release.

Two other suspects have been sentenced in connection with the robbery.

During the court hearing in July, federal prosecutors said Taylor failed a lie detector test related to the disappearance of Brittane Drexel within the past 30 days. Federal prosecutors say they are still working on compiling evidence in the Drexel disappearance.

After the hearing Taylor's attorney said he and his client met with the FBI three times and told agents Taylor has no idea what happened to Drexel.

"Unfortunately we couldn't provide the FBI or the Drexel family with anything beneficial of her whereabouts and unfortunately we've been kind of punished," Peper said.

Taylor's attorneys say they have filed a motion on July 7 to dismiss the federal indictment against their client on the grounds that "his rights under the double jeopardy, due process, and cruel and unusual punishment clauses of the United States Constitution have been violated by the subsequent indictment and prosecution of him in federal court for the same offense and on the same underlying facts as his previous state court conviction."

In its response to the motion to dismiss, federal prosecutors said they learned of Taylor's involvement in the robbery and subsequent punishment while investigating a separate crime – "the abduction and murder of a teenage girl in the Myrtle Beach and McClellanville areas."

Last summer, an FBI agent testified in open court that Drexel was abducted, gang-raped at a "stash house" in the McClellanville area, shot after trying to escape, and then her body was fed to alligators.

A jailhouse informant accused Taylor and his father, Shaun Taylor, of being directly involved in Drexel's murder, according to the agent's testimony.

Taylor has denied killing Drexel. At present, no one has been charged in her disappearance.

"He was in third period class in Lincoln High School the day that jailhouse rat says he was in this trap house in the middle of McClellanville, they know that is not correct," Peper said.

While investigating the Drexel case, "further inquiries into the details of the robbery indicated that the defendant's penalty was far below what his co-defendants received, particularly given his level of involvement, which justified a subsequent federal prosecution," according to the response to the motion to dismiss based on double jeopardy grounds, which was filed on Tuesday. "Despite agreeing to plead guilty, the defendant has filed this motion seeking to have his indictment dismissed on double jeopardy grounds. The government anticipates that the change of plea will go forward once this issue is resolved."

Taylor's attorneys said allowing the federal prosecution to go forward is an "abuse of the dual sovereignty doctrine and the concept of double jeopardy."

The prosecution noted that the double jeopardy clause would ordinarily prevent a person from being prosecuted twice for the same crime. However, they argue in their response that the dual sovereignty doctrine does not bar prosecution if the charges are brought by "separate sovereigns."

Activists call to free convicted robber suspected in Brittane Drexel case

MCCLELLANVILLE — Civil rights activists gathered at the Mount Zion AME Church in McClellanville Wednesday morning to protest the incarceration of Timothy Da'Shaun Taylor — a person of interest in the Brittane Drexel disappearance — before his trial on Jan. 30.

Spanish moss clung to trees that lined the two lane road, leading the church where John C. Barnett met with Taylor's friends and family gathered in hopes of freeing the man, who Barnett said had nothing to do with the Drexel case.

Drexel, who came to Myrtle Beach for a spring break trip without her parent's permission, was 17 when she went missing. She was last seen by her friends on April 25, 2009, leaving the Blue Water Hotel on Ocean Boulevard.

Police have been searching for her for almost nine years. In June 2016 police announced they knew the teen had been dead for some time, changing the missing person's case into a murder investigation.

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Later that year, the Post and Courier out of Charleston received FBI files stating that Drexel was beaten, gang-raped, shot and left with alligators near the McClellanville area.

Taylor was arrested in 2011 after he pleaded guilty to one count of conspiracy to commit a robbery for planning and driving a getaway car during an armed robbery of a Mount Pleasant McDonald's, and served a sentence for the crime.

However, federal charges for the McDonald's robbery were resurrected after investigators looking into Drexel's disappearance heard Taylor's name in their search for a suspect from another inmate, Taquan Brown.

Brown told investigators that he went to a house in the McClellanville area where he saw Taylor, then 16, "sexually abusing Brittane Drexel," the Post and Courier reported. He reportedly said that he saw Drexel trying to escape the house, but was caught and brought back inside. Brown said that he then heard two shots and that a covered body was brought out of the house and taken away.

Now, Barnett hopes to “shine a light on the area,” showing that Taylor has already served time for robbery charges, and said he is being held unfairly for a different case.

“I ask that you stop this witch hunt” Barnett said. “I strongly believe he has nothing to do with” the Drexel case.

In July, Assistant U.S. Attorney Winston Holliday told The Sun News that a polygraph test affirmed their belief that Taylor knew more about the Drexel case than he was saying.

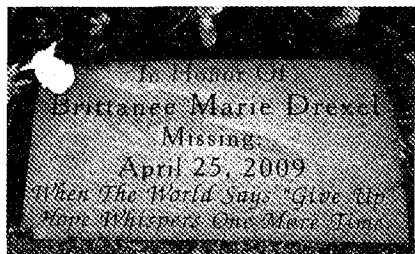
Holliday said that Taylor’s name came up “time and time again” in their investigation of Drexel’s disappearance after his name was first mentioned by the inmate.

During that time, federal prosecutors offered Taylor a deal — tell us where Drexel is and we’ll drop the charges in the robbery case. However, Taylor’s attorney, Mark Peper, said that Taylor “was in third period class at Lincoln High School” at the time the informants told police he was at the house with Drexel.

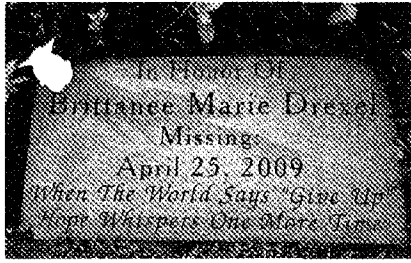
“It’s been hell,” Joan Taylor, Timothy Taylor’s mother, said. “I mean, we have people threatening us, we get obscene messages, I’ve lost my job of 11 years. Especially life for his kids, because his oldest son lives with us, and we try to screen him from hearing the stories on the news, and his daughter. And they miss him because he’s very active in their lives.”

Taylor has two kids, an 8-year-old and a 6-year-old, and attended the NASCAR Technical Institute in North Carolina.

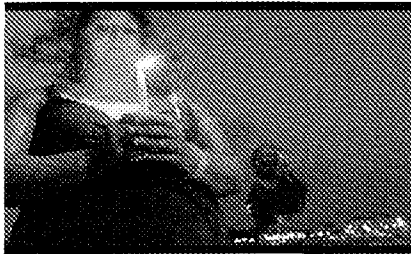

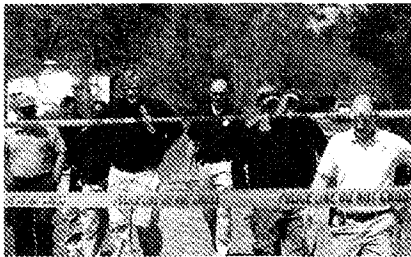

Now, Barnett is planning a demonstration outside the courthouse on Jan. 30 and is creating a petition to send to the Department of Justice.

"If they did this to brother Timothy, they're going to do it to someone else," Barnett said. "How dare you prosecute this young man? He was 16."

With the help of Barnett, Joan Taylor said that the family once again has hope.

“He feels good about somebody supporting him because it’s always been everybody talking negative,” Joan Taylor said. “This is the one time, I can tell you, that I’ve heard him laugh or seen him smile when I visited him in months. You know, the question was asked by him to me, ‘Why did they pick me? Why, mama, why did they pick me of all people?’”

Man implicated in Brittaneé Drexel case had his own suspicions, records say

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A McClellanville-area man told the FBI he didn't know who had a hand in Brittaneé

Drexel's disappearance and had never seen the teenager in person.

But Timothy Da'Shaun Taylor showed deception when he answered those questions in a polygraph examination, federal prosecutors said this week in seeking to imprison the 26-year-old for up to two decades.

Their argument came as Taylor awaits a sentencing hearing on an unrelated robbery charge that the FBI pursued as he refused to reveal helpful details about Drexel's presumed abduction and about whether he or his family was involved.

The officials had already said Taylor failed the exam, but court filings added new details about the suspicions he reported developing when the accusations against his family emerged.

Mark Peper, a West Ashley defense attorney for Taylor, said the government's filing "completely mischaracterizes" plea negotiations in the case, which included polygraph exams.

The test Taylor was alleged to have failed also indicated he had lied about his own name, Peper said. Such exams, which can be flawed, are typically not admitted as evidence in court.

Civil rights groups have protested the hefty penalty Taylor faces as unfair.

"The truth is, (federal prosecutors are) getting heat — rightfully so — for forcing him to do 10 to 20 years on a prior robbery since there was nothing to squeeze out of him on Drexel," Peper said Friday.

Drexel, 17, went missing in 2009 as the New Yorker spent spring break in Myrtle Beach. A jailhouse informant reported Taylor and his father kidnapped Drexel and held her at a trap house, where she was gang raped and shot before her body was dumped into an alligator swamp, the FBI said.

Taylor and his family have denied the allegations.

After Taylor was implicated, federal authorities pursued a charge against him in the same Mount Pleasant McDonald's robbery for which he was already serving a state probationary sentence. They argued his penalty was light compared with accomplices in the heist.

His lawyers portrayed it as an effort to force details from Taylor of Drexel's case.

Instead of revealing any key evidence, Taylor stood by his innocence. Because he had already pleaded guilty in the state robbery case, he had no choice but to do so again in the federal one.

His plea agreement calls for a prison term of 10 to 20 years.

The federal prosecutors filed the paperwork this week ahead of a sentencing hearing likely to be scheduled in the coming weeks. The documents revealed Taylor had told the FBI about an argument he overheard in June 2016 between two people whose names were redacted from the records.

The quarrel was sparked by an accusation that someone had Drexel's cellphone.

"Taylor advised that neither of them ever confided to him that they were involved in Drexel's disappearance," the polygraph report stated, "but Taylor thought the argument was suspicious."

During the questioning, the filings added, Taylor continued to deny withholding any information and started "shouting angrily."

The interview was ended.
