The Columbia Office first became aware of Davis
Wolfgang Hawke when the local Spartanburg, SC, newspaper, The
Herald-Journal, reported that Hawke was a resident student at
Wofford University and publicized information about his Neo-Nazi
white supremacist organization, the Knights of Freedom, being
operated from his dorm room. As a result of this negative
publicity Hawke posted information on the Internet about the
[redacted] their address and
home telephone number, [redacted] and
indicated that [redacted] would be available online
soon. He also posted a disclaimer that "our Party does not [redacted]

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Office referred this matter to the United States Attorney's Office, Greenville Division, to pursue a possible Civil Rights violation, however, AUSA [redacted] determined that no CR violation existed.

As a result of Hawke's Internet postings and newspaper articles he became the object of interest with the Spartanburg Department of Public Safety (SCDPS), the Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office (SCSO), and the South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED) Criminal Intelligence Section. The SCDPS attempted to interview him since Wofford College is in its territory. Hawke advised the investigating officer that he would only submit to an interview if a reporter with the Rolling Stone was present. The SCDPS Officer declined.

No investigation was conducted by the Columbia Division as there was no reasonable indication that any violations of federal law had occurred or were occurring.

On or about 06/28/1999, Columbia became aware of Boston Division's investigation of [redacted] through the [redacted] who had a source reporting on [redacted]

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Columbia Division has furnished information to the Washington Metropolitan Police Department, Intelligence Division, in preparation for the KOF march in Washington, DC, 08/07/1999.

On 07/09/1999, Sgt. [redacted] SCSO, advised that Wofford College had furnished him with a copy of an Internet posting, allegedly by the World Church of the Creator (WCOTC), which was discovered by the college after the Benjamin Smith incident in Illinois. According to this posting the WCOTC has created an "Anti-KOF Resource Center," which suggests that Hawke and his organization are fraudulent "white racialists," and they warn that he should, "Quit now! Leave! Disappear from the scene completely!...If you don't unlatch from your host now, you will end up being smashed under the hand of vengeance."

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of a transcript of a taped interview of subject Hawke which took place on 07/20/1999. During the interview Hawke indicates that he expects representation from the World Church of the Creator (WCOTC) at the 08/07/1999 demonstration in Washington, D.C. Hawke expects approximately 200 people to attend the demonstration in support of his organization/cause. He insists that his relationship with [redacted] is a cordial one, however, some of [redacted] are anti-KOF or ANP.

Hawke claims that the ANP membership includes members of the WCTOC, Aryan Nations, and National Alliance.

On page 16, Inv. [redacted] makes reference to "you're (sic) little sign there...." [redacted] explained the comments made by Hawke were about a sign hanging on the wall which read, "BOMB ABORTION CLINICS." Hawke explains the ANP is against abortion because they oppose the killing of white babies.

Hawke explains that he changed the name of the organization from KOF to ANP because KOF was too militant, and they were being confused with the militia.

DH: Now, the World Church of the Creator people and a lot of white supremacists, some of them do go on rampages like killing spree like you saw with Benjamin Smith, but if you look at people like [REDACTED] people like [REDACTED] people who've really screwed over white racialist, they're still walking around. They haven't been assassinated. What that tells me is that in general white supremacists are not the type to go around plotting to assassinate this, you know, this white person. What they do is after they can't take it, you know Benjamin Smith was arrested for distributing literature time and time again, they just can't take it and they blow up and they go nuts for a little bit. So I don't think any white supremacists whether or not he likes me, you know, or hates me like some of these World Church of the Creator people, would actually plot to come down here and do anything to me. I don't think that's how they work. I think it's just sort of a reaction. Suddenly they can't take it and they lash out at the system. Now, you know, I..I do sometimes worry about JDL or some of these..these Jewish groups of course despise me, but you know, they don't threaten. So I don't..I don't know. . .

That's what they hear from their parents. They don't realize and they really don't understand that what we want is political change, political reform. They just can't get away from the stereo-types.

DH: Well, for instance. Basically, we want the old values of America returned to America.

DH: We want fair treatment for whites and we want a white country for white people. That's basically the long and short of it.

DH: Well, basically since we are in favor of the white race, we feel that aborting white babies is harmful to what we stand for. We don't agree with it.

DH: Yeah. We try to not take a religious stand.

DH: It's the fact that it's a white baby that you're killing and if you want the white race to survive and multiply, you can't kill white babies. We..unlike the Church of the Creator is violent and anti-Christian (inaudible), we're not anti - any religion. We say religion is a personal matter. You deal with religion however you have to. We're solely focusing on the white race.

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DH: Right. In ten years, I would hope that (inaudible) our targets. I'm not going to go so far as to say that I'm going to be President or in power in the country or anything like that, but I would hope that in ten years we're a very strong, national political party just like the Republicans and Democrats. That's my goal.

DH: That's the goal. Yeah. That's why I changed the name from Knights of Freedom which sounded awfully militant, to American Nationalist Party because people were getting us confused with the Militia which we're not. None of our members are armed. We don't have stashes of weapons or anything like that.

DH: Oh, I've got a gun. She's got guns, but I mean..it's not..that's for our own personal protection and a lot of our SS security members have guns, but that's for protecting us, you know, at our private events held at private places. But we're not out training in the woods like the Militia. We're not..we don't have any militant plans. That's just not a goal.

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DH: Well, we've got some ex-military people, but they're not..they don't really specialize in that type of thing.

DH: Well, we do, but the way I designed the security force was it's mainly for private events. You know, at this event we didn't have any problems because we had it about five..five or ten SS officers patrolling the property armed, but we can't do that in DC. We can't have armed people in DC so we're relying just on the police basically. There's nothing that our SS can really do there.

DH: They contact employers and try to get them fired and contact their wives if they don't know about it. They cause all sorts of problems. In fact, the ADL said that they've had a file on me since I was in high school passing out just anti-government, not even racist flyers, on the street corners. They've been keeping a file on me ever since. They had something like seventeen thousand names in California alone. They were sued by law enforcement. Not because it was illegal I guess to keep the files, but because law enforcement wanted the files and the ADL wouldn't give it to them.

DH: So that's why a lot of people use a fake name. But there are a lot of doctors and lawyers believe it or not who are involved in the struggle and who saw what [redacted] so all the ADL has to do is make a phone call to the hospital or law firm and that guy's out of work, you know, his family is screwed.

That's just the way it is because they are liberal, the NAACP is liberals and white racialists are right wingers and unfortunately it tends to mold the minds of the public because, you know, two groups that are both political, they're both racially oriented, the ADL and the JDL, the Jewish Defense League, that's racially oriented. If you had something called the White Defense League, they would be certainly ostracized and probably investigated and all sorts of other things.

Four neo-Nazis abruptly call off Washington march

Police chief wants city to sue group for \$1 million it wasted

WASHINGTON — A Spartanburg County based neo-Nazi group abruptly canceled its planned rally Saturday in the nation's capital even though the city closed a number of streets and spent an estimated \$1 million on police to protect them, Metropolitan Police Chief Charles Ramsey said.

Four members of the South Carolina-based American Nationalist Party showed up to take part in the march in support of an Aryan homeland, Ramsey said. They told police who were to escort them to the beginning of the parade route that they would not march, he said.

Ramsey said he did not know who all the four were or whether one of them was the ANP's leader, David Wolfgang Hawke, a Wofford College student.

The march was canceled because huge counter demonstrations were planned and "the media worked this thing up into a frenzy," said Jeff Krause, executive vice president of the American Nationalist Party. "We did not want any of our people hurt," he said.

The group had a permit that would have allowed up to 300 supporters to march six blocks along Pennsylvania Avenue and hold a rally in Lafayette Square — the tiny park across the street from the White House.

A spokesman for the Metropolitan Police Department said Ramsey will ask the district's legal staff to sue the American Nationalist Party, formerly the Knights of Freedom, to recover the costs incurred for providing security for the march and several counter protests.

Since the media is to blame, Krause said, a suit against the party would be unfair.

City police and the United States Park Police deployed nearly 2,000 police officers in riot gear in the downtown area to deal with potential problems that never materialized.

"There also is an expectation that if you are going to do this sort of thing that you follow through," Ramsey said, noting that personnel and equipment costs could exceed \$1 million. "The taxpayers ought to be reimbursed," he said.

Authorities had worked on plans for controlling the neo-Nazi demonstration and several counter protests for more than six weeks. Portions of more than a dozen city blocks were closed for much of Saturday afternoon. "Our plan of action included street closures for the safety of the public," said Sgt. Robert McClean, a spokesman for the U.S. Park Police, which has jurisdiction in the vicinity of the White House.

The area of blocked off to general public access was similar to the security perimeter put in place for the NATO meeting earlier this summer.

Police also used steel barricades to divide Lafayette Park into two fenced perimeters where opposing demonstrators could express their views had Saturday's demonstrations gone off as planned.

"We shut them down cold today, and that's exactly what we set out to do," said Rami Elamine, an organizer of D.C. United to Stop the Nazis. The ad hoc coalition of community groups marched six blocks to Lafayette Square and held a noisy anti-Nazi rally that became a victory celebration.

ignorance festers," said Josh Trapp of Jackson, Mississippi.

At another counter-rally at the Lincoln Memorial, Mayor Anthony Williams called the planned neo-Nazi march a "chilling reminder" that at the start of the new millennium people still want to spread hate.

There are still people who think their "skin color gives them a mandate" to exclude others, Williams said. "We must speak up and we must speak out against hate now and always," he said.

Delegate Eleanor Holmes Norton blasted the neo-Nazis as "the ugliest part of America."

Neo-Nazis call off march

Only four members of Wofford student's group show up, but many come to protest

WASHINGTON — A planned neo-Nazi march led by a Wofford College student that put the capital city's police force on alert fizzled when just four members of the white supremacist group appeared for the Saturday demonstration.

D.C. Police Chief Charles Ramsey, who put 86 percent of his force on the streets in

anticipation of the parade down Pennsylvania Avenue and rally in Lafayette Square, said he would recommend to city lawyers that they sue the Knights of Freedom American Nationalist Party to recover the costs of the operation.

"I think they owe it to the taxpayers of the city," Ramsey said. "When we mobilize like this, they ought to pay for it."

Born Andrew Britt Greenbaum, Davis Wolfgang Hawke, a student at the Spar-

tanburg school, said on his Web site he founded the group "as an organization dedicated to the preservation of white culture and the defense of white rights."

In meetings with police, Knights of Freedom leaders indicated they would have 150 to 300 people marching. Counter demonstrators "made it very clear that they had every intention of trying to prevent the march from taking place 'by any means necessary,' which means we had to be prepared for anything," Ramsey said.

Ramsey figures the operation cost the city "upward of

\$1 million."

A Park Police helicopter buzzed overhead. Secret Service surrounded Lafayette Square, a park that fronts the White House. Police, elbow to elbow and on horseback, blockaded the Pennsylvania Avenue marching route until they heard word by radio that the Knights of Freedom had cancelled. Had the Knights marched, the police line would have kept them out of public view.

Ramsey said he rearranged schedules so he could put 1,500 officers downtown and

1,100 in the neighborhoods to cover regular beats. U.S. Park Police, who have jurisdiction over Lafayette Square, canceled leave and days off to make its entire force available.

Ramsey said he did not know why the group canceled. The Knights, lead by Hawke, were scheduled to meet a police escort between 2:20 and 2:30. Four members appeared.

"They decided not to do it and they got in their cars and left," Ramsey said.

At one point, a shoulder-to-shoulder police line shoved back a group of Jewish Defense League protesters who tried to get too close to the parade route. The JDL had threatened to stop the march.

In anticipation of the Knights of Freedom, counter demonstrators and police filled downtown streets. At the Lincoln Memorial, D.C. Mayor Anthony Williams and Eleanor Holmes Norton, the district's

delegate to Congress, lead a rally for "pluralism and respect" that featured performances by a Latin American singer, a Klezmer band and Peter Yarrow of Peter, Paul & Mary.

"Our nation — north to south, big city to rural hamlet — has declared that group hatred is un-American," Holmes Norton told about 250 people gathered on the Memorial plaza.

By 3 p.m., Lafayette Square filled with anti-Nazi banners and demonstrators. The International Socialist Organization flew its banner: "Unite to fight the Nazi right." The Anti-Racist Action Group marched under the slogan: "Organize to stop racist terror."

More than 200 people from Shalom International, a Jewish group from Miami Beach who had a permit to counter-demonstrate on the other half of Lafayette Square, waited in vain with banners and bullhorns, whistles and drums, for the Knights to arrive.

"What the Nazis did today was lose a major thing, not just here in D.C. but all over the country," said Shalom International President Robert P. Kunst. "That fact that they didn't show up only shows the color of their cowardice is even worse than we thought."

When the American Nationalist Party (formerly the Knights of Freedom) launched its Web site in August 1998, it touted itself as a neo-Nazi "state within a state" with a "stable power structure," seeking members "ready to take back our nation and battle for the cause of Racial preservation." It appears that ANP exploited the anonymity of the Internet to foster the illusion that it was a rapidly growing neo-Nazi organization. In reality, ANP's Web site - and, indeed, the whole organization - was run from the dormitory room of a college junior who hid behind a pseudonym for fear that his background might discredit him in the eyes of other racists.

Focus on the Founder

ANP's founder and leader was born Andrew Britt Greenbaum, and is a 20-year-old student at Wofford College in Spartanburg, SC. Greenbaum legally changed his name to Davis Wolfgang Hawke in 1996, but his attempt to affect Southern and German lineage has not been entirely successful. When his birth name was uncovered earlier this year, other extremists ridiculed Hawke for trying to mask his Jewish background. He vociferously denies any Jewish heritage. Hawke's rebuttal to his critics takes up an entire section on ANP's Web site. He claims that he is the product of an illicit affair between his mother and a German man, and that his "stepfather's" name was mistakenly put on his birth certificate. Hawke's mother denies his allegation.

Hawke, who majors in history and German, claims that his racist ideology crystallized when he was a student at a multiracial high school in

suburban Boston: "Seeing the problems caused by the minority students and the blindness of the white members of the community, I became determined to make a difference in the world."

Knights of Freedom (KOF) first came to the attention of authorities and ADL in 1996 when Hawke and a friend distributed racist, anti-Government and anti-immigrant flyers in Norwood, MA. At the time, KOF did not fashion itself as a neo-Nazi organization, but rather as a pro-white "political movement dedicated to Freedom, Natural Order, and the restoration of the traditional ideals of the founders of our Nation."

Knights Reborn as Nazis

Two years later, KOF resurfaced as an Internet-based organization that unapologetically embraced neo-Nazism. KOF's Web site featured Hawke (who assumed the pseudonym "Bo Decker" for his online activities) in a Nazi uniform with his arm stretched in a "Heil Hitler" salute. KOF had now dedicated itself "to establishing an Aryan homeland in the American West in which we may rebuild the glory of the National Socialist Third Reich and provide a haven for all loyal Comrades throughout the World."

Hawke's conversion to neo-Nazi ideology was complete. In a March 1999 speech to his followers, he said, "We must all carry with us in our hearts this knowledge; that the dreams of Adolf Hitler have not faded away, but are just as alive today as they were 60 years ago! The German army was defeated on the battlefield, but the Ideals of Adolf Hitler live on in the hearts and souls of those who now carry the torch of the Aryan peoples."

Hawke's grandiose view of "the Aryan peoples" is surpassed only by the overblown image he promotes about his own organization: he recently claimed that "KOF is now the largest National Socialist organization not only in this

country, but in fact throughout the entire world." Hawke claims to have 10,000 members, but no one seriously believes that he has more than a small fraction of that amount. Other than Hawke's cohorts - including ANP's vice-president Jeff Kay; Deputy Director "Dallas Knight"; Chief Party Secretary Patricia Lingerfelter; Security Services and Stormtrooper Leader Matthew McKenna - and a handful of contact people around the country, it is difficult to gauge the number of members.

Despite some leafleting of KOF propaganda, the group has had little visibility beyond the Internet. Hawke announced a number of KOF events (including a rally in Andrews, NC, against the "tyranny" of the Federal Government and the planned appearance of KOF members at a community meeting against racism in Brooklyn, NY) that were quietly abandoned. KOF's singular lack of any organized activity suggests that the group's membership is very small. Nevertheless, Hawke predicted that, "By the end of [1999], KOF will be a feared political force within this nation and a household name, a name which strikes terror and horror into the heart of every Race traitor, every jewboy judge, every race-mixing scum and every ZOG [Zionist Occupied Government] politician."

Spreading the Word: Hate Online

Although Hawke clearly exaggerated both the power and size of his group, he has been able to reach like-minded individuals on the Internet. In early 1999, KOF launched the E-mail-based "White Pride News Service" which purports to distribute newsletters and updates about the group to "1,600 white racialsists in 43 countries throughout the world." That Hawke and his fellow officers hid behind pseudonyms and never followed through on public meetings or rallies did not seem to deter potential members; KOF has apparently managed to recruit some members as a direct result of such Internet activities.

Hawke's "Millennium Plan" - released in June 1999 - signaled yet another transformation for KOF and its leader. As part of Hawke's attempt to take his organization in a new direction, he abandoned the nom de guerre of Bo Decker, and KOF was reborn as the American Nationalist Party. Ever sensitive to his growing number of critics, Hawke instituted these cosmetic changes in order to "improve the image of the Party" and to dispel the general perception that KOF was "a paramilitary neo-Nazi group with an element of 'Hollywood Nazism' mixed in." As Hawke explained to his supporters, "Since our goals are political in nature, we must dispel our image as a militia and ensure that the public sees us for what we are; a legitimate National Socialist political Party dedicated to defending white rights."

ANP's newly designed Web site - dominated by images of American flags and bald eagles - is characteristic of Hawke's attempt to retool his group's image. Since ANP aspires to real political legitimacy, the group posts its platform on a variety of domestic policy issues: immigration, affirmative action and crime.

Despite Hawke's attempt to offer ANP as a viable political force, his group is still very much a neo-Nazi organization. Among the articles in ANP's "On-Line Library" are What is National Socialism? by American Nazi Party founder George Lincoln Rockwell, The Truth About the Talmud and The Swastika. Also featured are a number of articles culled from other extremists on the far right, including Holocaust-denial propaganda from the Institute for Historical Review and an anti-Semitic essay by William Pierce, leader of National Alliance. In addition, visitors to the group's Web site can purchase Nazi memorabilia, including flags, armbands and jewelry.

Recruiting Young Haters

For Hawke, expanding ANP's membership base is essential if his group is to have any lasting

viability. Another significant element fueling ANP's membership drive is the money it attracts: ANP members pay \$5 in monthly dues. Not surprising for a group dominated by men under 25, ANP recruits heavily among teen-agers. The group has established a youth corps, geared to teens between the ages of 12 and 17, which is "committed to the education and enlightenment of white youth throughout the world." The aims of ANP Youth include "political education and current events knowledge, cultural studies of white heritage and history, recruiting within the schools and community youth groups, participation in our Rallies and Party functions, health excercises [sic] to build strength and endurance, and the discussion of important political works such as the Declaration of Independence, Mein Kampf, and the International Jew by Henry Ford."

Hawke's inflated statements about himself and ANP make it difficult to take either seriously. Nonetheless, some people are evidently paying attention. In less than a year, ANP seems to have managed to attract a number of followers, apparently aided by the group's well-designed Web site and frequent electronic mailings. In fact, Hawke's shrewd use of the Internet helps advance the illusion that ANP is a large-scale operation. Even if ANP does not have a significant presence off-line, any group that promotes racist and anti-Semitic propaganda to teen-agers over the Internet merits close attention.

Racism and Anti-Semitism from Davis Wolfgang Hawke:

- Who are we? . . . We're White Men who refuse to stand idly by as our Race gets gobbled up by the hordes of traitors, jews, and immigrants who seek to wipe us out. We're White Men who are ready to take back our nation for the cause of Racial preservation.
- The time for sitting back and waiting for a

miracle is over. The White Race will no longer wait for the Jewish butchers to deal the final blow to our racial gene pool.

- I would like to take this brief moment to publicly express my full and unswerving support for a man whom we should all admire and hail as a white hero. That man is John William King...Now don't get me wrong or think I don't care about the life of the poor negro James Byrd, Jr. I definitely think that Jon [sic] King should have been convicted, but only of cruelty to animals! No white man should ever be punished for ridding the world of a negro - They are not humans, but filthy, disgusting beasts!
- We have suffered long enough under the iron heel of Juda. We have encountered their lies, their money lending, their jack-booted ZOG mercenaries, and their oppression. They have stamped our great nation into the ground and destroyed every courageous Aryan who dared oppose the Jewish domination. For these crimes I hold them all accountable, as one people, and pronounce this judgment upon them; the extinction of that Race whose father is the Devil!

Neo-Nazis Bow Out of March

Almost 1,500 police officers in riot gear along Pennsylvania Avenue. Hymns and invocations to "stop racism now" at the Lincoln Memorial.

Raucous demonstrators at Lafayette Square carrying signs and speaking out against the growth of white supremacist groups in the United States.

Everybody showed up yesterday. Except for the instigators: the American Nationalist Party, a k a the Knights of Freedom, a self-styled neo-Nazi group.

The group, which applied for the permits to march down Pennsylvania Avenue and to rally in front of the White House as part of an "anti-government protest," told D.C. police to expect 150 to 300 demonstrators. Only four showed up at a staging area prepared by police, and they decided to call off the march.

"I'm not surprised," said Hyman Greenbaum, the father of the group's leader, Davis Wolfgang Hawke, a 20-year-old South Carolina college student.

City officials weren't so blasé.

Chief Charles H. Ramsey immediately announced he would urge the District to explore suing Hawke and his followers for the million-dollar-plus cost of deploying 1,450 D.C. police officers for the march in addition to 1,100 on regular duty.

About 300 U.S. Park Police officers also patrolled the area, backed by Secret Service and Federal Protective Service agents from as far away as New York. Police

cordoned off a 20-square-block area around the White House and Lafayette Square in preparation for the march.

"They decided, at the location where we were going to pick them up and transport them down here by bus, to call off the march," Ramsey, dressed in a helmet and carrying a riot baton, told a crowd of reporters at 17th Street and Pennsylvania Avenue NW. "Only a couple showed up. They immediately determined they weren't going to go through with it."

Police could not say whether Hawke was among the group. Attempts to reach Hawke yesterday by telephone were unsuccessful.

Jeff Krause, executive vice president of the American Nationalist Party, said the march was canceled because huge counter-demonstrations were planned and because "the media worked this thing up into a frenzy."

"We did not want any of our people hurt," he said.

Because the media was to blame, Krause said, a suit against the group would be unfair.

Nine years ago, a Ku Klux Klan march in the District erupted into violence when protesters pelted the marchers with rocks. Fourteen people, including eight police officers, were hurt, and 40 were arrested. In light of that incident, police officials said they had no regrets about the massive deployment of officers yesterday.

David C. Friedman, regional director of the Anti-Defamation League, said the cancellation of the march was "in many ways, a predictable result."

"A group that has existed largely as a student-run operation out of a dorm room and a Web site – it's not surprising they did this," said Friedman, who helped organize a "respect rally" at the Lincoln Memorial for racial and religious tolerance. "I think the city should take a hard look at seeking to recover the costs expended in the police protection required."

The American Nationalist Party was founded in 1996 and has about 150 members, many recruited through

Hawke's Web site, according to the Southern Poverty Law Center, which monitors extremist groups.

Upon hearing of the cancellation of the march, a massing of anti-Nazi and anti-racist groups led by D.C. United to Stop the Nazis, gathered at the northern edge of Lafayette Square, turned spontaneously into a victory celebration.

"Ho, ho, ho, the Nazis didn't show!" a group of 200 college-aged students chanted, as some blew whistles and banged on tin drums and plastic barrels.

On the steps of the Lincoln Memorial, about an hour before the neo-Nazi march was officially canceled, several hundred people gathered at the "respect rally" to evoke the words of the Rev. Martin Luther King Jr., who gave voice to the nation's civil rights movement.

Mayor Anthony A. Williams (D) noted that yesterday's march was scheduled nearly 36 years to the month after the 1963 March on Washington when King told the world of his dream of an America free from the troubles of racial inequality.

"That dream cannot be reserved for those who live in opportunity," Williams said. "That dream belongs to everyone."

The mayor said he recently received an e-mail from someone saying he shouldn't describe the neo-Nazi organizers as ignorant. His response: "This is an ignorant, stupid, foolish group!"

"No ragtag band of pitiful, disconnected people can overwhelm the human rights unity our nation has finally, if painfully, achieved," Del. Eleanor Holmes Norton (D-D.C.) told the throng of people who gathered under a piercing sun. "We've worked too hard, come too far. Hatred is just plain un-American."

In the end, the marchers never even materialized. Williams said late yesterday: "I am not disappointed that the planned neo-Nazi march was called off in our city today. There is no place in the District of Columbia for the racist, antisemitic, hateful messages expounded by groups such as this."

In a telephone interview last week from her suburban Boston home, Hawke's mother, Peggy Greenbaum, predicted neither her son – who legally changed his name to Davis Wolfgang Hawke from Andrew Britt Greenbaum before he entered college three years ago – nor his group would follow through with the march.

"I can't imagine Britt going down there," she said, using her son's former nickname. "Number one, he is a chicken. I don't like to say that about my own son, but he is a chicken."

On 08/07/1999, Hawke canceled the rally when only 4 supremacists appeared for the gathering that was met by hundreds of protesters. The embarrassing turnout contributed to Hawke and his organization losing credibility within the extremist movement. It is believed that Hawke's Knights of Freedom became defunct shortly after the failed rally in Washington. This matter was closed in the Columbia Division on 08/01/2000 when it was determined that Hawke's organization was no longer viable within the extremist movement and based on investigation that failed to establish that Hawke was stockpiling weapons.

On [redacted] Sergeant, Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office, advised that he believes Hawke [redacted]

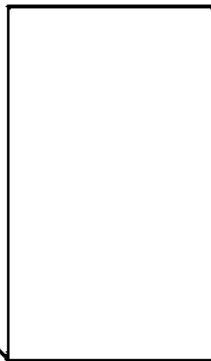

[redacted] Because this email was in HTML format, it also contained images found on that same web page. By looking in the HTML code in the email (see Attachment B) we found the web address where these images were residing. The images in question all had the same IP address:

We then tracked this IP address to the host provider, HiSpeed Technologies, with the contact person [redacted] spoke with [redacted] and explained that someone who is presently hosting a website with HiSpeed is sending unsolicited bulk email using [redacted] and has [redacted] the images from [redacted] on his server at Hi-Speed. Although [redacted] would not reveal [redacted]'s name, we did obtain the domain name from which these images are being stored: [redacted]. He also confirmed with logfiles that a person from a [redacted] uploaded those images to the [redacted] website. Coincidentally, a person from [redacted] originated the email messages. The images in question are not used anywhere on the [redacted] website.

Upon further investigation of the above domain (see Attachment D), the registrant of [redacted] has the same address as the address given in the original email (see Attachment A), however the company name in the email message is [redacted]. The website located at [redacted] has recently been disabled.

We then investigated the company [redacted] and found the domain [redacted] (see Attachment E). The registrant of this domain [redacted] was the same address as both the original email message and the registrant's address from [redacted]. This website was also hosted with HiSpeed Technologies, but has since been disabled. The administrative and billing contact [redacted] uses the same Post Office address with the exception of a change in PO Box number. The email he supplies on this registration is [redacted].

Upon investigating [redacted] (see Attachment F), the regis [redacted] lists the same address as [redacted] administr [redacted] act on [redacted] (see Attachment E). The administrative and billing contact on [redacted] is the same person listed as the administrative contact on [redacted] (see Attachment D) and lists the same address [redacted].
