In preparation for the remedial training for Shannon Mork, I spoke with Dave Springstun. Dave was at the trial and listened to testimony given regarding this shooting. He also has been able to talk to SIU and D-2 personnel and get some info from them. I also talked to Shannon to advise of the training schedule and I asked him what he felt he needed to work on the most. He chuckled and then said "you mean with the shotgun right." I said yes and he told me the reason he could not manipulate the shotgun was because he was trying to do it in the car and there was not enough room in there. He said he then heard the shots being fired so he got out of the car and ran to the back for cover. AWAY FROM THE PLACE WHERE HIS FELLOW OFFICER'S LIVES WERE BEING THREATENED!!!! Dave Springstun tells me that a D-2 Officer who had traffic stopped way behind Shannon heard the shots, grabbed his rifle, and left his roadblock post to run past Shannon and get in the fight!!!! That Officer joined the other D-2 units and covered the downed suspect while the car was cleared. Shannon did nothing! One might argue that Shannon was a secondary unit with other officers between himself and the suspect so he could not fire safely. However, all training he has ever received teaches that a secondary unit in a high risk stop is to exit his car immediately and move forward to the primary units to assist with the situation. D-2 Officer Gould was also a secondary unit who parked right next to Shannon. Officer Gould did as we are trained and it is my understanding that he was along the right side of the primary unit before the suspect started shooting. By Shannon's own admissions to me today, he was still in his car attempting to manipulate the shotgun when the suspect started shooting!

In our short conversation, Shannon told me he felt the 870 shotgun was "about the simplest peice of equipment to operate." Yet the operation of this simple piece of equipment was his reason for not engaging in a deadly force encounter.

I don't have great details of the shooting he was involved in just before this one. However, it is my understanding that when the suspect came out shooting, Shannon ran across the road (away from the threat) and hid in the bar ditch on the other side while YCSO engaged and killed the suspect from a position behind Shannon's patrol car. I do not know if Shannon even drew his pistol or chambered a round in a long gun in this case. I also have not heard what Shannon's reason was for not engaging this first suspect but it seems clear that he moved away and took no action. In this first case, Shannon was the primary unit. It is my understanding that he was the closest Officer to the suspect and had an unobstructed line of fire at him yet took no action.

Our minimum training time each year requires only basic proficiency with our weapons. Shannon is not the best shooter in the District, but he always shows proficiency at or above the minimum qualification requirements. We never know how someone will act (or not act) in a shooting based on their range performance. This is a mindset issue. I understand the necessity to complete remedial shotgun training based on his statements to investigators, however I'm not sure it will address the root of the problem.

I am greatly concerned with Shannons actions (failure to act actually) in these situations. I believe he has shown a pattern here which could wind up getting him or someone else killed in the future. He is very lucky other Officers were present to take care of him in both these situations. I believe he needs to be confronted by the chain of command about this. I will gladly be involved too if desired. I think he needs to be asked directly if he is too afraid of getting hurt or afraid to use deadly force. We need to see what his response is and deal with it accordingly, documenting our actions. I think if this happens again and someone gets hurt or killed, we will be asked about our failure to act and then we may be held accountable.

Forgive me if I have mis-spoken here or possibly mis-stated any facts. This is the information which has been relayed to me and I am sure you too understand my concerns.

I will complete remedial shotgun training with Shannon Mork at 1200 hours on Monday 1/5/09, at the Prescott Valley range.

Sergeant Moran,

To confirm our phone conversation earlier today, the Critical Incident Review Board determined that the actions of all DPS employees were reasonable when viewing the totality of the circumstances of Critical Incident #2008-9008C, involving Highway Patrol Division (HPD) Sergeant Brad Elliott, Officer Nathan Gould, Officer Shannon Mork, and several other HPD officers which occurred on May 2, 2008 on Interstate 17 south of Flagstaff. However, there was an area that required follow-up for action. Training and Management Services Bureau (TMSB) is to follow-up with the appropriate district firearms instructors to insure that Officer Mork's shot gun is inspected and functioning properly; and require that Officer Mork demonstrates proficiency with his issued shotgun.

Please forward a memorandum from the firearms instructor written to Commander Heape containing the dates, times, names, and activities performed to accomplish this follow-up action. The memorandum should be submitted no later than January 9. If a district firearms instructor is not available, please contact me and I will make arrangements for a firearms instructor from the Armory to assist. Please contact me if you have any questions.

I would like to have a mandatory shoot for Firearm's Instructors only on July 14th at 0800 hours. Instructor's please advise if you can attend on this date! Here's the shoot schedule.....

Night Shoot: (Maximum of 10 shooters per Session) 1700-2300 hours

Gentleman,

The FTU would like to take a moment to discuss important terminology that was introduced last fall and this spring at the Practical Handgun

emails.
Fundamentals and Marksmanship classes. This discussion involves the positions of "contact ready" and "on target and prepared to fire (prepped)". These are both very important positions and each are appropriate only at certain times during the deployment and firing of an officers primary handgun.

Contact ready: This is the position an officer assumes when he is accessing a possible deadly threat. The position is defined as "weapon extended toward threat, muzzle depressed to a level that the danger area of the suspect can be seen (hands) visual focus on the treat and trigger finger along the frame of the weapon". This is the appropriate position for a felony stop, or anytime an officer perceives a possible deadly threat but has not yet made a determination to fire.

On target and prepared to fire (Prepped): This is the position an officer takes when he has decided to fire at a deadly threat. The position is defined as "weapon aimed center mass of the threat, visual focus is on a crystal clear front sight and the trigger finger is on the trigger and has removed any slack from the trigger." From this position, accurate fire can be deployed.

It is important to make sure our students understand that we are not training them to put their finger on the trigger at any time other than when they are on target and have decided to fire. If they place their finger on the trigger while at contact ready or while scanning, they are violating one of the four basic firearms safety rules and must be immediately corrected.

AED Battery Checks, Hello AED Coordinators:

Please note:

I will need your battery check email to me within the first two weeks of the month. The battery check information is included in our division monthly report. Thank you for being diligent on these battery checks. Also as an FYI, last month through the safety office and with the assistance of various AED coordinators we serviced 15 AEDs with new batteries and AED pads. Again all of the AED maintenance information is maintained in Safety Loss Prevention in the AED Safety Program.

If you have already conducted your battery check and have sent me your battery check email, thank you.

Should the AED in your location exhibit a faulty battery check let me know

immediately. I maintain the AED registration and maintenance schedule spreadsheet. If you have any question on the AEDs please call me at x 2344.

Again, the battery check is an integral part of our AED program. It documents that the AED is "Ready for Use". This demonstrates the department's diligence in maintaining functional AEDs. And it reinforces employee expectation that the AED is functional.

Battery Check Instructions: Please conduct your AED battery check, and initial the AED inspection tag that is attached to the AED.

- * For AED cabinets that are alarmed, the alarm will sound when you open the AED cabinet door and the alarm will shut off when you close the cabinet door. However, after you open the door, if you hold the alarm plunger down it will silence the alarm as you do your battery check.
- * Send me an email stating that your battery check indicates "Ready to Use". If the battery check indicates "Low Battery", call the Safety Analyst immediately at extension 2344 or at DPS cell phone at 602-361-1494 and follow-up with an email.
- * We have AEDs made by five different manufactures:

1. For Welch Allyn AEDs : The battery level icon is to the left of the green power button.
 - * The AED is "Ready to Use" when the icon is solid black.
 - * When the icon shows a red circle with a slash through it or if it shows a flashing circle with a slash through it, you must call the Safety Analyst immediately.
2. For Samaritan Heartsine AEDs : The battery level icon (LED Status Indicator) is to the right of the sketch of the human head.
 - * The AED is "Ready to Use" when the battery level icon is intermittently flashing.
 - * When the battery level icon is not intermittently flashing, you must call the Safety Analyst immediately.
3. For Phillips HeartStart AEDs: The battery level is determined by the green "Ready" light.
 - * The AED is "Ready to Use" when the green "Ready" light on the defibrillator is blinking.
 - * When the green "Ready" light is off and or the defibrillator "Chirps", you must call the Safety Analyst immediately.
4. For Zoll AEDs: The battery level icon is in the status indicator window on the left side of the unit handle.
 - * The AED is "Ready to Use" when a "Green Check" symbol (check-mark symbol) is in the status indicator window.
 - * When a "Red X" symbol is in the status indicator window, you must call the Safety Analyst immediately.
5. Defibtech AEDs: The battery level icon (LED Status Indicator) is on the corner of the unit next to the unit handle.
 - * The AED is "Ready to Use" when the LED blinks green.
 - * When the LED blinks red and or beeps, you must call the Safety Analyst immediately.

Battery checks must be conducted on the first of each month. Once I receive your email, I will annotate your battery check in the AED spreadsheet. If any battery check indicates "Low Battery", I will do immediate follow-up on the AED. Each month I will send out an email as a battery check reminder. If

Hello to all.

I hope everyone is doing well this winter. Thanks for all you are doing out there to keep AZ safe.

Not a whole lot at the meeting, however here are some of the issues I think you might want to hear about.

LODD -

Line of duty deaths are up this year too, 7 already in 2011, 3 more than last year and 15 since the last meeting. We ended up with 162 in 2010, 34 more than the previous year.

PLEASE BE CAUTIOUS AND ALERT OUT THERE> STAY SAFE.

Legislative report - The Governor put out her proposed Budget on her web page (www.azgovernor.gov) to see her 4 pillars of reform for state government.

1. Economic competitiveness 2. Education 3. State Government 4. Renewed Federalism

Her budget was good for DPS with no cuts. Other legislative moves are to move capitol police to DPS and increase DPS funding for DNA testing of prisoners. Also to get a waiver from federal gov't for Heath care issues and roll back prop 204.

PENSION REFORM -

Basically all the pension plans are being looked at VERY closely by the Legislature right now. All will have changes and some possibly very drastic. It is believed that PSPRS would only change amounts for future DROPS payouts. The state wants to do away with the Pensions and move to 401k type investing for retirement. It causes alot of problems in the mean time while the employees finish with the current pension system. There is alot of legislation for pensions and our lobbyist and president Chavez is monitoring it closely.

DIRECTOR HALLIDAY

The director spoke about the current state of the department and some future plans, but mostly answered questions from the Rep's at the meeting. He stated he wanted to do away with Furloughs all together, and will be handing control to Deputy Director Dennis Young. He (Halliday) feels it will serve the department well if he is doing the necessary political posturing (my term) for the Dept and can let Young run the Dept when he is on board and ready to go, soon. The Director does not know if will be able to hire anyone until we know that we can sustain what we have. If it comes to more budget cuts, the only place we have to go is people. The Department is still looking at options to consolidate. FY 2012 looks like we are could have a billion dollar shortfall in projected revenue. The Department is looking at consolidating Districts 11 and 12. No prediction on promotions, overtime, new cars, some discussions on each topic. Some discussion on the Secondary Employment was held. 20 additional officers will be trained (to be used as needed) in dignitary protection. There has been an additional officer added to Governors Security. Some discussions on department patch and if DPS patch should be changed especially if we absorb the Capitol Police and have to

work on new job descriptions, etc. emails

Lt.Col Hegarty: some discussion on changing a work week from a 40 hour cycle to a 160 hour cycle which would create some flexibility in working some 10 or 12 hour shifts. Curious about what our members thoughts are about it. A 160 hour cycle would help to consolidate metro PHX into a couple shifts better than a 40 or 80 hour cycle. (AHPA voted to not oppose a 160 hour work cycle if proposed in legislation. We want to make sure there would be a mechanism in place where people can keep their overtime if accrued early in the cycle.)

Lt. Col Stanhope: CI Budget will be posted on the Intranet and will include CI positions. CI has developed a strategy to help assist patrol if it is needed. It will not be published because we will help as needed when needed. Look ahead three or four years as many people are in DROPS, there will be opportunities for promotion. KASE Management system and new vehicles would be the priority if there are any year end monies. CI is looking at consolidating a command position in Flagstaff with GIITEM and Narcotics when Captain Gerard retires.

The PSPRS member stakeholders have agreed that they will not accept any changes to the retirement system for current employees. There are 2 members on the retirement board that are up for appointment.

There was a brief discussion regarding the Pursuit policy and slimming it down and having more training on it.

That the majority of the items you may want to know about. As ALWAYS, if you have any issues, ideas, thoughts or concerns that I can bring to the AHPA or Executive staff, Please let me know. Thank you for your membership in AHPA and your dedication to DPS and the STATE of AZ.

WHITE SUPREMACIST ACTIVITY:

Aryan Brotherhood Inmate Charged with Murder in Arizona
Authorities in Phoenix, Arizona, have charged a white supremacist inmate with the murder of another inmate at the Fourth Avenue Jail in Maricopa County. Pete Van Winkle, 26, a member of the Aryan Brotherhood racist prison gang, allegedly beat to death fellow prisoner Robert Leroy Cotton, 28, on May 1, 2008. It has been reported that Cotton was also once an Aryan Brotherhood member, but had recently renounced his affiliation. Court documents state that Van Winkle stomped on Cotton's head and choked him for 15 to 20 minutes while in the cell. At the time of the attack, the cell was out of sight and sound of the security tower and all the monitors. It was not until Van Winkle allegedly dragged Cotton's body out of the cell and attempted to lift him up and throw him over the second floor railing that a detention officer spotted the men. Detention officers arrived at the scene, where they found Van Winkle covered in blood. Officers attempted CPR on Cotton but were unable to revive him. Van Winkle was arrested and rebooked for first-degree murder. Van Winkle has an extensive and violent criminal history, and was incarcerated awaiting trial for attempted second-degree murder charges at the time of the incident.

Arizona Racist Skinheads Sentenced for Attempted Murder

A Maricopa County, Arizona, judge has sentenced four racist skinhead defendants for their role in the attempted murder of one of their own gang members in 2006. Kelly Ann Harkins, 29, received an 18-year sentence on June 3, 2008, after pleading guilty to attempted first-degree murder. In January 2006, four members of the Arizona Northern American Skinheads/SS Guardians,

emails
a loosely organized racist skinhead group, took Amanda Crow, a 19-year-old recent recruit of the group, into the desert outside Phoenix where they beat her, slit her throat and severed her spinal cord, and left her for dead. Crow ultimately survived the attack, but remains paralyzed from the neck down. While in the hospital Crow was able to identify the first names of several assailants. The Anti-Defamation League provided police with names and photographs of possible suspects, helping them identify the assailants. In February 2006, police arrested Kelly Ann Harkins of Tucson, and Edward Maurice Ware, Jessica Laura Bruner, and Jason Matthew Shakofsky, all from metropolitan Phoenix. In November 2007, Ware received a life sentence after pleading guilty to conspiracy to commit first-degree murder. In May 2008, Bruner, 26, received a 21-year sentence after pleading guilty to attempted first-degree murder, and Shakofsky, 28, received a seven and a half year prison term after pleading guilty to hindering prosecution in the first degree. Holocaust Denier David Irving on Speaking Tour in the Southwest
In May, Holocaust denier David Irving began a speaking tour across the United States. On June 18, 2008, Irving spoke in Phoenix, Arizona to a crowd of approximately 30 people. Attendees were required to pay a \$20.00 entrance fee to hear his lecture, which included a discussion about his arrest and incarceration in Austria, and promotion of his books. Irving lectures internationally and has appeared at conferences held by the Institute for Historical Review and the neo-Nazi National Alliance. In denying that the Holocaust happened, Irving told a Canadian audience in 1990 that people claimed to be survivors because "there's money involved and they can get a good compensation cash payment out of it."

White Supremacist Convicted of Cocaine Possession in Washington (arrested in Tucson, Arizona)
On June 11, 2008, a superior court jury in Cowlitz County, Washington, convicted Zach Beck, 29, of Longview, of felony cocaine possession, bail jumping and driving with a suspended license. The judge then sentenced Beck to 16 months in state prison for the cocaine charge and 16 months for bail jumping; the sentences to run concurrently. Beck represented himself at trial. Beck, a member of the neo-Nazi Aryan Nations, was arrested at the Tucson airport on December 20, 2007, and extradited to Longview. A bench warrant was issued for Beck in November 2007, for failure to appear in court Cowlitz County on a felony cocaine possession charge. The DOC also issued a warrant for Beck for several alleged probation violations, including failing to report, using drugs, and leaving the state without permission. In fall of 2007 Beck rented the city-owned McClelland Arts Center in Longview to hold a neo-Nazi rally. Beck had already fled by the time of the December rally, but other white supremacists carried it out, prompting a large counter-protest. Beck has an extensive criminal history. In 2005, Beck was convicted of first-degree burglary and third-degree assault in Cowlitz County and served 33 months. Beck has been convicted of numerous other crimes in California, Idaho, Arizona and Washington, including fraud, driving under the influence, and domestic violence. In 2004 Beck was convicted of shooting at police officers during a standoff at his home.

Colorado White Supremacist Threatens Judge at Sentencing
A federal judge in Denver sentenced a white supremacist inmate who assaulted

a prison guard to 20 more years in prison. A jury convicted Jeremiah "Jay" Vaughn Gregory of assault in February 2008 for throwing hot floor-wax stripper at a prison guard's face at the U.S. Penitentiary in Florence, Colorado. The guard suffered first-and second-degree burns. According to the prosecutor, after throwing the heated liquid, Gregory tried to break a light tube so he could stab and kill the guard with it. Gregory admitted in court documents that his original plan was to kill a Congressman. He planned to throw hot cleaning fluid on the Congressman and other individuals scheduled to visit the prison, then stab and kill as many of them as possible with a broken broom handle. During the May 16, 2008 sentencing, Gregory told the judge that he regretted that he "will not be able to [urinate] on your grave next to Alan Berg." Alan Berg was a Jewish radio talk show host in Denver who was murdered in 1984 by members of the white supremacist terrorist organization The Order. The Order carried out armed robberies, assassinations and other crimes in an effort to overthrow the government and create a white homeland. The group collapsed in the mid-1980s after all of its members were either incarcerated or killed. Gregory has claimed to be a member, but never was. The judge sentenced Gregory to serve the 20 years consecutively to two other 20-year prison terms he is currently serving for bank robberies in Utah and Montana.

Colorado Racist Prison Gang Leader Sentenced to 112 Years
A U.S. district court judge in Denver, Colorado, sentenced a member of the 211 Crew racist prison gang to 112 years in prison. The judge sentenced Danny Shea, 33, on June 22, 2008, following his April conviction on charges of conspiracy, assault, distribution of drugs, and witness tampering. The judge added 16 years to the sentence for violating Colorado's Organized Crime Control Act. Shea was indicted three years ago for his role in planning an attack against a 211 Crew "prospect" at the Sterling Correctional Facility, where both men were incarcerated. A four-year multi-agency investigation announced in January 2005 resulted in indictments against 32 members or associates of 211 Crew for numerous crimes, including attempted murder, assault, robbery, racketeering, bribery, witness tampering, and manufacturing and distributing drugs. In December, 2007, another 211 Crew leader, Benjamin Davis, received a 108-year prison sentence for similar charges. Davis started the white supremacist gang, named after the California penal code for robbery, in the Denver County Jail in 1995 while serving a 30-year sentence for burglary. 211 Crew gang members were recruited in prison, but continued their criminal activities after their release. They were expected to continue their gang allegiance by selling drugs and weapons on the streets to earn money for the gang.

ISLAMIC EXTREMIST ACTIVITY:

Guantanamo Detainee Faces War Crimes Charges for U.S. Bomb Plot
A former British resident from Ethiopia held in Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, faces war crime charges for his alleged role in an Al Qaeda plot to bomb targets, including apartment buildings, in the U.S. Binyam Mohammed, 29, is accused by the Pentagon of planning to attack targets in the U.S. with natural gas and a "dirty bomb" - a radioactive bomb. The U.S. Military Commissions' Convening Authority, which oversees the tribunal system, must approve the charges before an arraignment is scheduled. Mohammed traveled to Afghanistan in June 2001, where he fought alongside the Taliban and was trained in explosives in an Al Qaeda camp, according to the Pentagon. He later met with Khalid Sheikh Mohammed and Jose Padilla in Pakistan, where he allegedly received information on how to build a radioactive "dirty bomb." The Pentagon contends that Khalid Sheikh Mohammed, who is being arraigned on

charges for his role in the September 11, 2001, terrorist attacks, directed emails Binyam Mohammed and Padilla to attack American targets. Mohammed was arrested in Pakistan in April 2002 and transferred to Guantanamo Bay in September 2004. He faces a maximum sentence of life in prison if convicted.

FYI..The attached unclassified document from the Site Institute contains information on the Mubtakker Improvised Chemical Device (ICD). The design for the Mubtakker ICD was seized from a known jihadist computer in Saudi Arabia in February 2003. While exploiting the jihadist computer, operatives from the intelligence community discovered an al Quaida inspired plot to attack the New York City subway system with several Mubtakkers.

In September 2003, analyst from the intelligence community approached Chief Hanson (retired) with this information and requested to use WMATA CAD drawings of train cars and stations to conduct dispersion modeling for the ICD. While the results from the dispersion modeling remain classified, the information has been shared with the FBI, TSA , and many mass transportation police chiefs. Please review the attached document

Mexico: The Evolution of a Guerrilla Group
Bombs exploded early Sept. 10 at five or more points along natural gas pipelines operated by Mexico's state-owned oil monopoly Petroleos Mexicanos (Pemex) in Veracruz state, forcing the company to suspend shipments to parts of Mexico. The attack, which began with the first blast at about 2:15 a.m. local time and ended about 4 a.m., started fires and led to the temporary evacuation of some 12,000 people from nearby towns.

The attack, which Mexican authorities say was an act of sabotage, comes two months after the guerrilla group Popular Revolutionary Army (EPR) claimed responsibility for a similar attack against Pemex pipelines in Queretaro state near Mexico City and in Guanajuato state. In that statement, the group demanded the release of two of its members from prison. One of the lines attacked in July, the one running from Mexico City to Guadalajara, also was struck in the most recent attack. In August, the group planted two bombs in the southern Mexican city of Oaxaca. One device, planted at a Sears store, detonated in the early morning hours, while the other, placed at a Banamex bank branch, did not explode.

EPR, whose core membership is made up mostly of peasants, historically has expressed its anger at the Mexican government by shooting or vandalizing government facilities in the more rural areas of southern Mexico. Occasionally EPR has joined loosely with other leftist groups to plant small improvised explosive devices (IEDs) in Mexico City for the purpose of making political statements. Until the summer, however, staging multiple strikes against pipelines seemed beyond the capability of rural farmers.

It appears likely, then, that these attacks are being led by a fairly experienced bombmaker, perhaps an educated Marxist who has associated himself with the group. One indication of this is the lack of reports that unexploded IEDs have been found on the pipelines. Moreover, the attackers have avoided detection and have left authorities no clues. These latest bombings strongly suggest that the EPR -- or at least one of its cells -- has evolved, is expanding its target set and is increasing its operational tempo. This bombmaker likely has the ability to construct IEDs that are more powerful than the devices commonly used by the group. At this time, however, the cell appears to be committed to limiting human casualties.

Pemex increased security at its facilities after the July attacks, but pipelines are generally difficult to secure completely. In addition, the attackers can benefit from the violence occurring in Mexico as a result of the government crackdown on the drug cartels. Mexican security services

already have their hands full with ^{emails} the daily cartel violence.
